PLAYER NOTES

- **William Nylander** scored on a Maple Leafs power play opportunity at 14:40 of the first period and scored his second goal of the game at 19:46 of the third period. With two goals tonight, Nylander set a new single-season NHL career-high in goals improving to 42 goals scored this season (surpassing his previous career-high of 40). Nylander has recorded six points (4G, 2A) in his last two games. Nylander marked his ninth multi-goal game of the season and his 24th multi-point game of the season.
- **Auston Matthews** scored on a Maple Leafs power play opportunity at 4:46 of the second period, posting his 28th goal of the season. With the goal, Matthews posted the 714th point of his NHL career claiming sole possession of sixth on the franchise all-time list for most points, passing George Armstrong. Matthews also posted the secondary assist on Nylander's second goal of the game, posting his 38th assist of the season. Matthews extended his current point streak to three games where he has posted five points (1G, 4A). Matthews marked his 18th multi-point game of the season.
- **Scott Laughton** scored for Toronto at 15:13 of the second period, posting his 12th goal of the season and first goal as a Maple Leaf.
- **John Tavares** scored for Toronto at 19:02 of the third period, posting his 33rd goal of the season. Tavares also registered the secondary assist on Nylander's power play goal, recording his 34th assist of the season. Tavares extended his current point streak to five games where he has posted 11 points (6G, 5A). Tavares marked his 17th multi-point game of the season.
- **Matthew Knies** posted the primary assist on Nylander's power play goal and the primary assist on Matthews' power play goal, improving to 24 assists recorded this season. Knies marked his third multi-assist game of the season and his ninth multi-point game of the season.
- **Mitch Marner** recorded the secondary assist on Matthews' power play goal, the primary assist on Tavares' goal and the primary assist on Nylander's second goal of the game, improving to 67 assists recorded this season. Marner is currently ranked third in the league among assist leaders. Marner extended his current point streak to three games where he has posted six points (1G, 5A). Marner marked his 17th multi-assist game of the season, his 29th multi-point game of the season and his seventh game of the season with three or more points.
- **David Kämpf** registered the primary assist on Laughton's goal, posting his seventh assist of the season. Kämpf has recorded a point in back-to-back games (1G, 1A).
- **Oliver Ekman-Larsson** recorded the secondary assist on Laughton's goal, posting his 25th assist of the season. With his assist, Ekman-Larsson recorded the 500th point of his NHL career.
- **Steven Lorentz** skated in his 300th career NHL game tonight.
- **Joseph Woll** stopped 30 of 35 shots he faced in tonight's shootout loss.

- **Morgan Rielly** was on the ice for a team-high 23 Toronto shot attempts-for at 5-on-5.
- **David Kämpf** finished the game with a team-high 5-on-5 shot attempt percentage of 66.67 percent (6 for, 3 against).

TEAM NOTES

- The Maple Leafs have posted an 8-4 record in overtime decisions this season.
- The Maple Leafs were 2-for-4 on the power play and 3-for-4 on the penalty kill tonight.
- Toronto has posted a 20-12-3 record on the road this season.
