### AT A GLANCE

#### ON THE ROAD AGAIN

The Kings kick off their season-long seven-game, 15-day road trip to go into the league's Christmas Break tomorrow night on Long Island, including additional stops in against the Devils (Dec. 12), Rangers (Dec. 14), Penguins (Dec. 17), Flyers (Dec. 19), Predators (Dec. 21) and Capitals (Dec. 22). Of the team's remaining nine games this calendar year, all but one (Dec. 28 vs. EDM) will be played against Eastern Conference opponents. The Kings are 6-2-2 against cross-conference foes this season with a +8 goal differential and have won five of their six most recent matchups against clubs from the East, dating back to Oct. 17 at Montreal.

#### LIKE FINE WINE

Kings skaters have a cumulative 50 multi-point player games amongst their roster so far this season, 11 of which have come from **Adrian Kempe** and nine from captain **Anze Kopitar**. The 2024-25 season marks the fifth different campaign in the last 30 years to have at least 50 cumulative multi-point games by Kings players at this point in the campaign. Kopitar has recorded the most such instances in Kings history by a forward his age or older, with the next closest behind being **Larry Robinson** (1989-90) and **Luc Robitaille** (2002-03), each with four occurrences. Kopitar is one of just eight skaters in League history to have at least nine multi-point games through the first 25 games of a season at age 37 or older, and is the first since **Martin St. Louis** (10 GP) in 2012-13.

#### THE ISLES FILES

Several Kings are set to enter UBS Arena with impressive portfolios of recent showings against the Long Island-based franchise. Center **Phillip Danault** (3-2=5) looks to extend his point streak against New York to a sixth game, dating back to Feb. 26, 2022, while winger **Trevor Moore** has six points (3-3=6) in his five contests against the New York Islanders as a member of the Kings, dating back to Jan. 27, 2022. Forward **Adrian Kempe**—whose opening tally in the clubs' most recent meeting on March 11 stood as the game-winner in the Kings' 3-0 shutout—aims to push his personal point streak (2-1=3) to a fourth consecutive game versus the Islanders. On the blueline, **Vladislav Gavrikov** (1-2=3) has averaged a point-per-game against the Islanders since joining the Kings midway through the 2022-23 campaign.
