TOP NOTES

Zach Benson's goal gave him five points (1+4) in his last five home games.

Dylan Cozens recorded an assist on **Benson's** goal and he has also tallied five points in his last five home games (2+3).

Tage Thompson has registered 16 points (11+5) in his last 14 home games as a result of his goal. **Thompson** has posted 19 points (9+10) in his last 12 games against the Red Wings.

Jason Zucker notched the lone assist on **Thompson's** goal, giving him one assist in four consecutive games. His current four-game assist streak is the second-longest assist streak of his career (five games; Nov. 23 to Dec. 2, 2016).

Zucker's second goal of the game gave him three points (2+1) in tonight's contest. It marked the 15th time he has recorded three or more points in a single game in his career, and the first since Feb. 10, 2024 as a member of the Arizona Coyotes (0+3). Tonight's game marked his third multi-point performance of the season.

Peyton Krebs registered an assist on **Benson's** goal and **Zucker's** first goal tonight, which marked the fourth multi-assist performance of his career and the first since March 15, 2023 at Washington.

Nicolas Aube-Kubel's goal was his first as a member of the Sabres.

Beck Malenstyn registered the primary assist on **Aube-Kubel's** goal and he has recorded at least one assist in back-to-back games for the third time in his career. He last did so from Jan. 5 to 7, 2024 with Washington (0+2).

Ryan McLeod assisted on both of **Zucker's** goals in tonight's game. It marked his second multi-assist game this season (Nov. 5 vs. Ottawa; 0+2) and it was the seventh such performance of his career.

Buffalo has allowed just three power-play goals in the team's last 31 penalty-kill opportunities (90.3 percent).

Buffalo has scored five or more goals in five of the team's last six games at home against Detroit.
