#### THINGS YOU SHOULD KNOW

Buffalo has earned at least one point in four of its last five home games against Philadelphia and nine of its last 11 against the Flyers overall.

Buffalo ranks fifth among all NHL teams in penalty kill percentage (90.0) and it is one of eight teams that had allowed four or fewer power-play goals.

**Jeff Skinner** has recorded at least one point in six consecutive games (4+5) and a point in tonight's game would extend his point streak to seven games.

A point in tonight's game would give **Skinner** a seven-game point streak, which would tie the longest point streak of his career.

**Tage Thompson** has recorded eight points (4+4) in his last four games and a point in tonight's game would give him a five-game point streak.

**Thompson** has registered three points in two of his last four games.



**Owen Power** is riding a four-game point streak (1+3) and a point in tonight's game would extend his point streak to a career-best five games.

**Alex Tuch** has notched six points (1+5) in his last four games, including at least one point in each game.

JJ Peterka has tallied one point in three consecutive games (2+1) and a point in tonight's game would give him a four-game point streak, which would tie for the longest of his career.

**Casey Mittelstadt** has notched one goal in consecutive games and a goal in tonight's game would give him his longest goal streak of his career.

**Rasmus Dahlin** has recorded nine points (2+7) in his last nine games.

#### HOME - AND - HOME

Tonight's game concludes Buffalo's first and only home-and-home set this season, which opened with a 5-2 win over the Flyers on Nov. 1.

Buffalo has swept each of its last three home-and-home series against Philadelphia.

The Sabres' record in home-and-home situations against the Flyers is 11-3-1 all-time

# ON THIS DATE

The Sabres are 9-7-2 all-time on November 3.

November 3, 1990: Benoit Hogue scores twice and Daren Puppa stops 30 of 31 shots as the Sabres top the Bruins 4-1.

November 3, 2008: Ryan Miller makes 24 saves to record his second consecutive shutout and the ninth of his career in a 2-0 win at New Jersey.

#### STREAK - A - LEEK

The Sabres currently have five skaters (JJ Peterka, Owen Power, Jeff Skinner, Tage Thompson, Alex Tuch) who are riding point streaks of three or more games. Power (four games), Thompson (four games), Tuch (four games) and Skinner (six games) are all riding point streaks of four or more games.

Buffalo's longest point streak of 2022-23 (seven games) was achieved by Skinner (Feb. 15 to 28, 2023; 5+5), Thompson (Feb. 15 to 28, 2023; 6+5) and Tuch (Jan. 16 to 26, 2023; 3+6).

Rasmus Dahlin's empty-net goal on Oct. 29, 2023 gave him and eight-game point streak (Oct. 14 to 29, 2023; 2+7) and he became the third Sabres defenseman (Housley, John Van Boxmeer) to tally a point in eight or more consecutive games at least once.
