TEAM NOTES

TONIGHT'S MATCHUP

● The Maple Leafs are skating in their third game of the series tonight taking on the Senators at Canadian Tire Centre. The Maple Leafs have posted a 34-48 record in Game 3's in franchise best-of-seven series (12-20 on the road). Toronto has posted an 18-8 record in 26 playoff games against Ottawa. The Maple Leafs have outscored the Senators 66-46 in 26 postseason meetings. The last occasion the Maple Leafs met the Senators in the postseason was the Conference Quarter Final in the 2004 Stanley Cup Playoffs with Toronto capturing the series win (4-3).

LAST GAME

● The Maple Leafs won a 3-2 overtime decision against the Senators on Tuesday night at Scotiabank Arena. Max Domi scored the first overtime goal of his playoff career with Morgan Rielly and John Tavares (PP) scoring a goal each for Toronto in regulation. Tavares also registered the secondary assist on Rielly's goal, recording his second assist of the postseason. Tavares has recorded four points (2G, 2A) in his last two games and marked the 14th multi-point game of his playoff career. Mitch Marner recorded the primary assist on Tavares' goal. With the 54th point of his playoff career, Marner claimed sole possession of 10th on the franchise all-time list for playoff points, passing Syl Apps. Marner has recorded four points (1G, 3A) in his last two games. William Nylander posted the primary assist on Rielly's goal, recording his second assist of the postseason. Nylander has registered three points (1G, 2A) in his last two games. Simon Benoit recorded the lone assist on Domi's goal, posting his first assist of the postseason and first point of his playoff career. Anthony Stolarz stopped 26 of 28 shots he faced in Tuesday's overtime win.
