## JUICY JANUARY

Forward **Adrian Kempe** returns to DTLA with a team-leading 35 points (15-20=35) after collecting his team-high 20th helper of the season in the Kings' 4-3 shootout victory over Edmonton on Saturday. Kempe helped seal the victory with the lone shootout goal, marking his 20th career shootout goal and fourth game-deciding shootout tally of his career. His four game-deciders are tied for fifth-most in team history while his 20 shootout goals place second all-time behind **Anze Kopitar** (43 S/O G). Among active skates with at least 40 shootout attempts, Kempe's 46.5% shooting percentage is the fourth-highest League-wide. In the Kings' first outing against Dallas on Oct. 23 at American Airlines Center, Kempe scored his second overtime winner in as many games (also Oct. 21 at STL).

## AT THE DROP OF A HAT

Forward **Alex Laferriere** faces off against Dallas with two goals and four points (2-2=4) in his last five games, including his 12th marker of the year on Saturday in Edmonton. Laferriere's goal over the weekend came two games removed from registering his 11th goal of the campaign while playing in his 200th career NHL regular season game on Wednesday, Jan. 7, vs. San Jose. Laferriere is the 20th different Kings skater to score in their 200th career game and is the first to do so since **Quinton Byfield** (1-0=1; Nov. 23, 2024). Additionally, the native of Chatham, N.J., is the second Kings player to do so against the San Jose Sharks, joining Sean Avery (1-0=1; Dec. 26, 2005).

## A BRANDT NEW YEAR

Defenseman **Brandt Clarke** picked up his 15th and 16th assists of the season on Saturday at Rogers Place as part of his sixth multi-point game of the season. With his pair of helpers, Clarke eclipsed the 20-point plateau for the second consecutive season. His 16 assists place third among all team skaters behind **Adrian Kempe** (20 A) and **Quinton Byfield** (19 A). Clarke's two-assist night came just one week removed from his game-deciding shootout goal (GDG) in his first career shootout attempt on Saturday, Jan. 3, against the Wild.
