AT A GLANCE

KEEPERS OF THE CASTLE

Vezina Trophy finalist Darcy Kuemper has recorded two of the best games of his career so far this week, making 44 saves in Game 4 and 43 in Game 5, respectively tied for the sixth and eighth most he has ever made in a single game across 478 combined regular season and postseason appearances. Kuemper, who played a career-high 78:14 minutes in Game 4 on Sunday, matched Jonathan Quick (87 saves from April 13 – 15, 2012) for the most saves over a two-game span in the playoffs in franchise history.

KING OF KINGS

Captain Anze Kopitar (0-1=1) picked up his seventh helper of the playoffs on Tuesday night at Crypto.com Arena, tying him for the League-lead in assists this postseason. Kopitar (1-7=8) becomes the 10th different skater in NHL history aged 37 or older to record eight points in any five-game span in the Stanley Cup Playoffs, the first to do so since Joe Pavelski posted eight points (7-1=8) from May 2 - 11, 2023 as a member of the Dallas Stars. Kopitar is joined by Nicklas Lidstrom (3-5=8; April 18 - May 3, 2009) as the only skaters born outside of North America to accomplish the feat. Kopitar is the only member of that list to record as many points in a five-game span to open the postseason.

EXTRA JUICE

Forward Adrian Kempe (0-1=1) picked up his team-leading 10th point (4-6=10) of the playoffs with his sixth helper and League-leading sixth power play point (0-1) 6=6). Kempe's performance over this five-game span also ties Wayne Gretzky (5 GP in 1991) and Daryl Evans (5 GP in 1982) for the fewest games to 10 points in a postseason in Kings history, per NHL PR. The native of Kramfors, Sweden, enters Game 6 as the fourth Kings skater to record 10 points in a single postseason series in the past 30 years.
