MATCHUP NOTES

- ★ CBJ snapped a four-game losing streak in the series (0-3-1) in the most recent meeting on Apr. 8, 2025.
- ★ The Blue Jackets have earned points in five-straight home games of the series (3-0-2) and 10 of the past 11 since Nov. 24, 2017 (8-1-2).
- ★ The home team won all 3 games of the 2024-25 series and has earned points in 10 consecutive in the series since Apr. 22, 2022.
- ★ Four of the past seven played at Nationwide Arena have been decided after regulation (2 OT / 2 SO).
- ★ Seven of the past 10 games played in Columbus have been decided by a single goal (CBJ 4-1-2 in those games).
- ★ The teams have combined for five goals or less in three of the last four meetings overall.
- ★ Columbus has scored a power play goal in five-straight home contests in the series (6-of-11; 54.5 pct.).



JACKET TO WATCH - D Zach Werenski

Has 4-15-19 with 5 multi-point efforts in 19 career games against Ottawa, including assists in 9 of last 10 (0-12-12). Has tallied points in each of his last 7 home games (2-7-9).



SENATOR TO WATCH - RW Claude Giroux

Has 14-28-42 with 10 multi-point efforts in 43 career contests against Columbus. Has assists in the last 2 meetings and points in 5 of the last 6 (3-4-7).



TEAM NOTES

- ★ Columbus completed a three-game road trip, the third trip of three or more games this season, with a 4-1 loss at Carolina on Tuesday. The team played a franchise-high 18 of its first 30 games of a campaign on the road.
- ★ The Jackets begin a four-game homestand on Thursday. The club is 5-0-3 at Nationwide Arena since Oct. 29, tying for the second-longest home regulation unbeaten streak (4th time) and trailing only a 12-game streak from Feb. 11-Mar. 31, 2013 (9-0-3).
- ★ The Blue Jackets have played in 12 one-goal games (5-1-6) in their past 17 overall, including 10 decided after regulation.
- ★ CBJ rank second in the NHL in goals scored by defensemen and seventh-T in total points with 22-47-69 in 30 contests.
- ★ Columbus has scored a power play goal in four of the past five contests (5-for-16; 31.3 pct.). The team has converted on 9-of-38 opportunities over the last 15 contests since Nov. 11 (23.7 pct.; 9th in NHL).

PLAYER NOTES

- ★ C Adam Fantilli has posted 9-5-14 in 17 games since Nov. 8 (.83 points-per-game). He has scored 35 goals in 74 games in 2025, tied for the fourth-most goals (third time) in a calendar year in club history (Nash, 43 in 2009; Atkinson, 42 in 2018; Nash, 39 in 2006).
- ★ G Jet Greaves has stopped 269-of-294 in his past 10 starts since Nov. 11 (.915 SV%, 2.41 GAA).
- ★ C Sean Monahan has collected 3-4-7 in the past six games, while RW Kirill Marchenko has points in three of the past four outings (2-1-3) after each registered an assist on Tuesday.
- ★ D Zach Werenski has recorded points in 11 of the last 14 games overall (5-14-19). He ranks second in the NHL in TOI/GP as well as leads league blueliners in multi-point efforts and shots on goal and ranks second in points and third in goals with 9-21-30, 10 multi-point GP, 112 shots and 26:38 TOI in 30 contests.
- ★ Werenski has points in eight-straight games at Nationwide Arena since Oct. 29 (5-9-14), while Marchenko has points in each of his last six home contests (1-6-7) as well as 9-of-10 in 2025-26 (3-7-10).
