AT A GLANCE

WAR-REN PEACE

Forward **Warren Foegele** returns to SAP Center for the first time since recording his first assist (0-1=1) as a member of the Kings, his third point (2-1=3) against the Pacific Division rival Sharks in a six-day span at the end of October. Foegele has now scored three points (2-1=3) in his last two games against the Sharks and carries a three-game road assist streak (0-3=3) and five-game point streak (4-3=7) against the franchise, both dating back to Nov. 9, 2023 (with EDM).

MR. NOVEMBER

Forward **Trevor Moore** heads north to San Jose with a point in (0-2=2) in each of the Kings' previous two matchups against their in-state rivals this season. In 20 meetings since joining the Kings, Moore has recorded 10 (4-6=10) points all-time against the Sharks, including one game-winning goal and a pair of shorthanded tallies. The native of Thousand Oaks, Calif. started the month of November with a career-long eight-game point streak (2-8=10) from Nov. 2 vs. Chicago through Nov. 16 vs. Detroit. By recording his 10th assist of the campaign against the Red Wings, Moore became the fourth Kings skater in the last five years to establish a point streak of at least eight games: (**Adrian Kempe**, 9 GP in 2023-24; **Alex Iafallo**, 9 GP in 2019-20; **Kevin Fiala**, 8 GP in 2023-24).

BET, CZECH, RAISE

Goaltender **David Rittich** turned aside 19 of 20 Kraken shots Saturday afternoon at Crypto.com Arena to improve his season record to 7-5-0 and bring his regular-season career win total to 199 (199-62-24). With his next victory, Rittich would become just the eighth Czech-born (Jihlava, CZE) netminder in NHL history to reach the 200-win mark, and the 58th undrafted goaltender to win as many games. The netminder has collected points in eight of his last 10 starts against the San Jose Sharks, dating back to Dec. 31, 2018 with Calgary. Since joining the Kings a couple seasons ago, Rittich has maintained a 1.82 GAA and .915 SV% against the Sharks with a 4-1-1 record in six starts.
