AT A GLANCE

JUICE IS LOOSE

Forward **Adrian Kempe** takes the ice at Enterprise Center looking to extend his goal streak against the Blues to a sixth straight game, dating back to March 4, 2023, and his point streak to an eighth game (7-2=9), dating back to Nov. 3, 2021. Should he score this evening, Kempe would join **Dave Taylor** (7-2=9 in 7 GP from Jan. 26, 1985 – Jan. 16, 1987) as just the second Kings skater to record a six-game goal streak against St. Louis in team history. Kempe (6-1=7) would become the 19th skater in NHL history to record such a run against St. Louis and would be just the second player in the 21st century to do so, joining **Rick Nash**, (7-0=7 in 7 GP from March 27, 2007 – Feb. 17, 2008). The forward can also become the first Kings skater to post an eight-game *point* streak against the Blues since **Luc Robitaille** recorded 13 points (7-5=13) across eight contests from March 24, 1990, through Dec. 12, 1992. His current seven-game streak against St. Louis is one of 11 runs of at least that length in Kings franchise history. In total, Kempe has recorded 15 points (10-5=15) in 26 games against the Blues, including a pair of shorthanded tallies and an overtime game-winner.

STEADY EDDY

Defenseman **Joel Edmundson** skates into Missouri for his third career road game against the team that drafted him 46th overall in the 2011 NHL Draft. Over 130 regular season appearances at Enterprise Center as a member of the Blues, Edmundson notched 30 points (11-19=30) and accrued a plus-17 rating from 2015-16 through the 2018-19 campaign, which culminated in his first Stanley Cup Championship. The 31-year-old defender has three points and a plus-2 rating over his last four games following the League's break for the 4 Nations Face-Off, including his fifth tally of the season on Monday night against Vegas. On Saturday, Feb. 22, the native of Brandon, Manitoba, recorded his second multi-point effort of the campaign (0-2=2), and second consecutive multi-point performance against the Utah Hockey Club (2-0=2 on Oct. 26).
