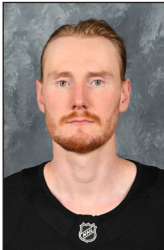

TOP NOTES

Tonight's win extended Buffalo's winning streak to eight games, the longest such streak since the team's 10-game winning streak from Nov. 8 to 27, 2018. It marked Buffalo's ninth winning streak of eight or more games in franchise history, and the fourth since since 2005-06.

The Sabres' win marked their first home winning streak of three or more games vs. the Bruins since they earned four straight home wins against Boston from March 30, 2008 to April 11, 2009.

Ryan McLeod's goal gave him three points (1+2) in his last three games. It marked his fourth point streak of three or more games this season and the ninth such streak of his career.

Peyton Krebs' two points gave him four points (1+3) in his last two home contests against the Bruins. His goal marked the 5th game-winning goal of his career and the first since Jan. 11, 2024 vs. Ottawa.

Tage Thompson registered the primary assist on **Krebs'** goal and an assist on **Josh Norris'** empty-net goal and he has collected 11 points (7+4) in his last eight games against the Bruins. **Thompson** has now recorded 13 points (6+7) in his last 12 games, including five points (2+3) in his last four home games.

Mattias Samuelsson recorded three points in tonight's game (1+2), the highest single-game total of his career. Entering tonight, **Samuelsson** had tallied two points in a single game on seven occasions.

Samuelsson has posted six points (1+5) in his last five games including tonight's contest.

Bowen Byram's assist on **Samuelsson's** goal gave him five points (2+3) in his last three games, including at least one point in each game in that span. His assist tonight marked his third point streak of three or more games this season.

Jack Quinn tallied two primary assists tonight (**McLeod** and **Samuelsson** goals), which marked the 11th multi-assist game of his career and his second of 2025-26 (Oct. 22 vs. Detroit; 1+2). He is now 10 assists away from matching his single-season career high (24 assists in 2024-25).

As a result of his goal, **Josh Norris** now has 11 points (5+6) in his last 10 games. **Norris** extended his point streak against the Bruins to six games and he has recorded seven points (5+2) in that span.
