TIME MACHINE

AT A GLANCE

Defenseman Drew Doughty returns to Crypto.com Arena ahead of his 100th career Stanley Cup Playoffs game tomorrow evening. The two-time Stanley Cup champion has made the most postseason appearances in franchise history by a defenseman and is slated to become the 15th active blueliner to play 100 career games in the Stanley Cup Playoffs. With teammate Anze Kopitar having just reached the milestone Friday night in Game 3 and Ottawa's Claude Giroux set to reach the century mark earlier in the day tomorrow with the Senators' Game 5 against Toronto, Doughty will become the 50th active skater to do so.

WAR-REN PEACE

Forward Warren Foegele returns to Crypto.com Arena after scoring his first goal of the postseason in Game 4 at Rogers Place, while his last appearance in DTLA saw him net a pair of assists (0-2=2) in the Kings' win in Game 2. With three points (1-2=3) so far in the series, Foegele now owns 27 career playoff points (13-14=27) and now sits one back of teammates **Kevin Fiala** (14-14=28) and **Adrian Kempe** (15-13=28), who are tied for 12th most playoff points among skaters selected in the 2014 NHL Draft. The two-assist performance last Wednesday marked the third multi-point effort of Foegele's playoff career (2-1=3; April 15, 2019, vs WSH (w/ CAR), 1-1=2; June 21, 2024, vs FLA (w/ EDM)).

KING OF KINGS

Captain Anze Kopitar has scored seven points (1-6=7) so far this series, the most in an initial four-game postseason span by any skater aged 37 or older in NHL history. Only three other players have come within a point of Kopitar's performance in the Stanley Cup Playoffs at his age or older: Jaromir Jagr (1-5=6) in 2012, **Doug Gilmour** (3-3=6) in 2002, and **Jean Beliveau** (2-4=6) in 1971.
