## AT A GLANCE

### A DIFFERENT TYPE OF HOME-RUN

The Kings open their four-game homestand Thursday against Detroit riding a seven-game home point streak (6-0-1) against the Red Wings, dating back to March 15, 2018. It marks the Kings' fifth different active home point streak against a single opponent, while being one of five clubs to have a home point streak versus Detroit of at least seven games in length. Overall, the Kings are 8-1-1 in their last 10 games vs. Detroit at Crypto.com Arena, dating back to the 2014-15 campaign.





### 8 MILE(STONE)

Defenseman **Drew Doughty** returns to Crypto.com Arena two days removed from scoring his first goal of the campaign, the 161st of his career, to tie **Rob Blake** for the most goals by a defenseman in LA Kings history. In 1,218 career regular-season games, Doughty has registered 161 goals and 690 points (161-529=690) with 80 power play goals, eight overtime goals, 34 game-winning goals with a cumulative plus-70 rating and is the eighth defenseman in NHL history to skate in 18 seasons for a single franchise. He is joined by Pittsburgh's **Kris Letang** as the only two active blueliners to achieve the feat. Doughty currently leads all team skaters in time-on-ice per game (TOI/GP) with 23:31 minutes, which ranks 27th-highest among all League blueliners. Of Doughty's 1,218 career games played, he has logged 25:00 minutes or more of TOI in 830 of them, nearly 68% of his career, and over 26:00 minutes in 646 contests, or 55% of his career.



### THE KING OF KINGS MEETS THE WINGS

Captain **Anze Kopitar** skates into tonight's rendez-vous with the Red Wings having averaged a point-per-game (1-6=7) in his last seven appearances against Detroit, dating back to Feb. 2, 2022. Among active skaters, Kopitar's 51 points (19-32=51) against the club from the Motor City rank as the fourth most in NHL history; he trails **Nikita Kucherov** (21-31=52), **John Tavares** (20-34=54), and current Red Wing **Patrick Kane** (18-38=56). Should the captain find the scoresheet tomorrow night at Crypto.com Arena, Kopitar will not only tie Kucherov for the third most against Detroit among active players but will also tie **Wayne Gretzky** (14-38=52) for the fifth most in Kings franchise history against the Original Six organization.



