PLAYER NOTES

- **William Nylander** scored the game-winning goal for the Maple Leafs in tonight's shootout, with **Auston Matthews** also scoring for Toronto during the shootout.
- **Nicolas Roy** scored for the Maple Leafs at 13:34 of the second period, posting his fifth goal of the season.
- **Max Domi** scored for Toronto at 2:32 of the third period, posting his ninth goal of the season. Domi is currently on a five-game point streak where he has recorded seven points (3G, 4A).
- **Nicholas Robertson** posted the primary assist on Roy's goal. With his 14th assist of the season, Robertson set a new single-season career-high in assists. Robertson has recorded a point in back-to-back games (1G, 1A).
- **Oliver Ekman-Larsson** registered the secondary assist on Roy's goal, recording his 25th assist of the season. Ekman-Larsson has posted two assists in his last three games.
- **Auston Matthews** posted the lone assist on Domi's goal, recording his 20th assist of the season. Per NHL Stats, "Matthews recorded his 20th assist of the season and became the fifth Maple Leafs player to post 10 consecutive seasons with that many since the start of their career. The others are Dave Keon (15), Morgan Reilly (13), Mats Sundin (13) and Borje Salming (12)... Matthews factored on Max Domi's game-tying goal to record his 248th career point in the third period and pass George Armstrong (247) for sole possession of the fourth most in Maple Leafs history. Mats Sundin (341), Darryl Sittler (317) and Dave Keon (281) round out the top three." Matthews has recorded four points (1G, 3A) in his last three games.
- **Joseph Woll** stopped 28 of 30 shots he faced in tonight's shootout win.
- **Brandon Carlo** was on the ice for a team-high 38 Toronto shot attempts-for at 5-on-5.
- **Brandon Carlo** finished the game with a team-high 5-on-5 shot attempt percentage of 73.08 percent (38 for, 14 against).

TEAM NOTES

- The Maple Leafs have posted an 8-9 record in overtime decisions this season (a 1-1 record in shootouts).
- Toronto has posted a 9-12-3 record on the road this season.
- At 6:59 of the second period, a coach's challenge was initiated by Toronto to determine whether there was goaltender interference on Vancouver's goal. Per the NHL's Situation Room, "Video review determined Vancouver's Conor Garland impaired Joseph Woll's ability to play his position in the crease prior to the puck entering the net. According to Rule 69.3, "If an attacking player initiates contact with a goalkeeper, incidental or otherwise, while the goalkeeper is in his goal crease, and a goal is scored, the goal will be disallowed."
Result: Call on the ice is overturned – No Goal Vancouver
