1. CONTEST RULES

2. CONTEST PERIOD

5.1 Prize Awarding:

Should such an attempt be made, the Organizer reserves the right to seek damages to the fullest extent permitted by applicable law.

9.7 If any section of these Rules is declared or held by a court of competent jurisdiction to be illegal, unenforceable or invalid, then that section shall be deemed invalid, but all other unaffected sections shall be enforced to the fullest extent permitted by law.

9.8 The Organizer reserves the right, at its sole discretion, to cancel, terminate, modify or suspend, in whole or in part, the Contest at any time if an event or human intervention occurs that could alter or influence the administration, security, impartiality or conduct of the Contest as contemplated by these Rules, subject to the approval of the *Régie des alcools des courses et des jeux du Québec,* if required.

9.9 In the event of a discrepancy between the English and French versions of these Rules, the French version shall prevail.

9.10 Any litigation respecting the conduct or organization of a publicity contest may be submitted to the *Régie des alcools, des courses et des jeux du Québec* for a ruling. Any litigation respecting the awarding of a prize may be submitted to the *Régie* only for the purpose of helping the parties reach a settlement.
