MATCHUP NOTES

- The Blue Jackets have won four-straight in the all-time series and have earned points in 13 of the last 20 meetings since 2014-15 (11-7-2).
- CBJ have earned points in nine of the last 12 games at Nationwide Arena dating back to Apr. 12, 2013 (8-3-1).
- The teams have combined for seven-plus goals in seven of the past 10 meetings of the series, while the winning team has scored four or more goals in nine of the last 12 contests.
- The winning team has scored five-plus goals in six of the past 10 games at Nationwide Arena, including in fourstraight since Mar. 19, 2022 (CBJ; 3-1-0).
- The club is 11-of-32 (34.4 pct.) on the power play in the past 12 matchups and have scored a PPG in five consecutive home games (5-of-14; 35.7).



JACKET TO WATCH - C Sean Monahan

Has posted 9-10-19 with 5 multi-point efforts in 27 career GP against St. Louis. Has assists in his last 4-straight GP (1-6-7) as well as points in 6 of the past 7 GP (3-6-9).





BLUE TO WATCH - LW Pavel Buchnevich

Has 7-9-16 in 21 GP against the Blue Jackets. Has recorded 4-6-10 in the last 9 contest, including points in each of his past 5 GP at Nationwide Arena (1-4-5).



TEAM NOTES

- Columbus won its third-straight game and for the fifth time in the past six contests after earning a 6-3 victory over Toronto on Wednesday.
- CBJ, who finished 6-4-0 in October, kick off November with their third consecutive back-to-back set on Saturday vs. St. Louis and Sunday at the NY Islanders. The club is 3-1-0 in the first two of 15 back-to-back sets.
- The Blue Jackets scored in all three periods for the third-straight game and fifth time this season on Wednesday and have scored in 22-of-the-30 periods played in regulation in 2025-26.
- The team ranks third in the NHL in shots-per-game (32.6) and seventh in faceoff percentage (52.6).

PLAYER NOTES

- C Charlie Coyle set a single-game career high in assists and plus/minus on Wednesday with 0-4-4 and +5 and has posted points in four of the past six contests (1-6-7).
- RW Kirill Marchenko and LW Dmitri Voronkov both collected an assist on Wednesday vs. Toronto and have each notched points (5-5-10) in eight of the ten games this season.
- C Sean Monahan sits one point from 600 for his NHL career (263-336-599, 828 GP). He would become the fourth player from the 2013 NHL Draft class to reach the mark, joining C Nathan MacKinnon (1,032 points), C Aleksander Barkov (782 points) and C Elias Lindholm (613 points).
- F Cole Sillinger, who has points in two of the last three contests (2-2-4), notched his fourth career multi-goal game and fifth three-point effort with 2-1-3 on Wednesday.
- RW Mathieu Olivier set single-game career highs in assists, points and plus/minus, finishing with 1-3-4 and +4 against the Maple Leafs on Wednesday.
- D Zach Werenski (3-5-8, 10 GP) has notched 1-1-2 in each of the past two contests. He ranks third in the NHL in TOI/GP (25:56) as well as leads league blueliners in shots on goal (36) and ranks second-T in goals in 2025-26.
