THINGS YOU SHOULD KNOW

The Sabres are 5-1-0 in their last six games, including wins in each of their last two.

Since Jan. 1, Buffalo has allowed just 50 goals in 23 games, the fewest goals allowed in the NHL in that span.

Seven of Buffalo's last eight games have been decided by one goal.

In Buffalo's last 19 games, **Ukko-Pekka Luukkonen** has made 17 starts and has recorded 423 saves on 454 shots (.932) in that span.



Rasmus Dahlin has registered three points in his last three games (1+2).

In his last four games, **Owen Power** has tallied four points (2+2).

Jeff Skinner has recorded four points (2+2) in his last four games.

Dylan Cozens has 16 points (7+9) in his last 16 games, including eight points in his last eight games (4+4).

Casey Mittelstadt has totaled three points (1+2) in his last two games, including one assist in both of those games.

JET FUEL

Rasmus Dahlin has registered six points (2+4) in his last five games against Winnipeg, including at least one point in each of his last three games against the Jets (0+4).

An assist in tonight's game would make **Dahlin** the first Sabres skater since Nathan Gerbe from Oct. 29, 2010 to Nov. 8, 2011 (four games) to record an assist streak of four or more games against Winnipeg.

Alex Tuch has notched one point in each of his last two games against Winnipeg (1+1).

In his last four games against the Jets, $\ensuremath{\text{Tage Thompson}}$ has recorded four points (1+3).

In two starts against Winnipeg in his career, **Ukko-Pekka Luukkonen** has recorded a save percentage of .919 and a goals-against average of 2.53.

<u>March 3, 2006</u>: Derek Roy records his first NHL hat trick in a 6-2 win over the Toronto Maple Leafs in Buffalo.

BAGK-TO-BAGK

Tonight's game concludes Buffalo's ninth of 12 back-to-back sets in 2023-24, which opened with a 7-2 win against the Vegas Golden Knights last night.

The Sabres are 5-4-0 in the first game of back-to-back sets and 3-5-0 in the second game so far this season.

Buffalo's point breakdown in back-toback sets this season is: four points (0), three points (0), two points (7), one point (0) and zero points (1).
