STREAKIN' VS. CBJ

Pittsburgh enters tonight's game with points in 16-consecutive home games against the Columbus Blue Jackets dating back to December 21, 2015.

- Pittsburgh's 16-game home point streak against Columbus is the longest active home point streak against one team in the NHL:

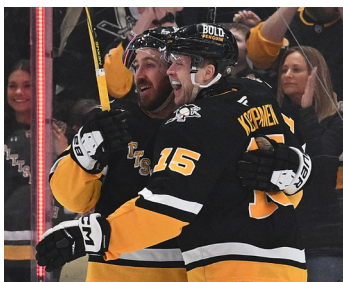
Joona Koppanen became the 41st player to skate in a game with Pittsburgh this season on Tuesday against the New York Islanders.
