THINGS YOU SHOULD KNOW

The Sabres have earned a win in three of their last four games against the Golden Knights.

Buffalo has earned at least one point in five of the six home games it has played against Vegas all-time (4-1-1).

Tage Thompson has posted 33 points (18+15) in his last 29 games, including 18 points (12+6) in his last 14.

Thompson has registered multiple points and at least one goal in back-to-back games and a goal today would give him his fifth goal streak of three or more games this season.

A multi-point performance today would mark the second time **Thompson** has recorded multiple points in three consecutive games this season (Oct. 19 to 26, 2024; 4+3).

Rasmus Dahlin has registered 20 points (5+15) in his last 19 games and 16 points (2+14) in his last 14 home games.

Alex Tuch has collected 14 points (9+5) in his last 14 games.

Josh Norris has notched one point in two consecutive games (1+1) and a goal today would give him his third three-game point streak this season.



In his last four games, **Ryan McLeod** has recorded four assists, including one assist in back-to-back games.

An assist in today's game would give **McLeod** the longest assist streak of his career (three games).

Zach Benson has registered four points (1+3) in his last four games.

Jason Zucker has recorded one point in three straight games against Vegas (2+1).

In two starts against Vegas in his career, **Ukko-Pekka Luukkonen** has earned two wins and posted a .940 save percentage and a 2.00 goals-against average.

In that span, Luukkonen made 63 saves on 67 shots.

ON THIS DATE

The Sabres are 7-11-5 all-time on March 15.

March 15, 1997: The Sabres get goals from six different players, including two from Brian Holzinger, to pick up the 1,000th victory in franchise history, a 7-5 win at Philadelphia.



TOMMY DANGLES

Tage Thompson leads all Sabres skaters in goals (34), points (58), points per game (1.00), even-strength goals (29), even-strength points (45) and shots (181).

Thompson ranks second in even-strength goals among all NHL skaters, trailing only Leon Draisaitl (34).

Thompson is one even-strength goal away from becoming just the third Sabres skater to record 30 or more even-strength goals in a single season since 1993 (Jason Pominville, 2006-07, 30 EVG; Jeff Skinner, 2018-19, 32 EVG).

Both Pat LaFontaine (31 EVG) and Alexander Mogilny (49 EVG) reached that mark in 1992-93.

Thompson is on pace to record 45 goals this season, which would be the second-most goals he has registered in a single season in his career (2022-23; 47 goals).
