### THINGS YOU SHOULD KNOW

The Sabres have won four of their last five games against the Senators, including three consecutive wins.

A win in today's game would mark the first time Buffalo has earned four or more straight wins against Ottawa since the team won four straight against the Senators from Nov. 29, 2016 to Dec. 12, 2017.

In his last 13 games, **Ryan McLeod** has posted 16 points (4+12) and has collected 18 points (4+14) in his last 14 road games.



**McLeod** has recorded at least one point in back-to-back games and he has posted four points (1+3) in that span.

**JJ Peterka** has tallied 27 points (13+14) in his last 24 games and he has registered 15 points (6+9) in his last 13 games.

**Peterka** has registered two points in each of his last two games and a multi-point performance tonight would mark the second time he has recorded multiple points in three straight games this season (March 3 to 6, 2025; 2+4).

**Tage Thompson** has posted 40 points (22+18) in his last 38 games, including five points (4+1) in his last five games.

**Peyton Krebs** is riding a career-best four-game point streak and he has tallied five points (2+3) in that span.

**Jack Quinn** has recorded at least one point in four consecutive games and he has tallied eight points (4+4) in that span.

In his last five games, **Alex Tuch** has posted seven points (5+2).

**Tuch** has recorded at least one goal in three straight games and he would match the longest goal streak of his career (three times) with a goal in tonight's game.

**Owen Power** has notched one assist in three consecutive games and an assist tonight would give him his third four-game assist streak of the season and match the longest assist streak of his career.

### ON THIS DATE

The Sabres are 19-5-4 all-time on April 1.

April 1, 1973: The Sabres clinch their first-ever playoff berth with a 3-1 win vs. St. Louis on the last day of the season.

April 1, 1997: Rob Ray plays in his 500th NHL game and becomes the 17th player in franchise history to play 500 games as a member of the Sabres.

April 1, 2008: Buffalo earns the 1,400th win in franchise history with a 4-3 victory at Toronto.

### THE SIXTH SENS

**JJ Peterka** has registered six points (4+2) in his last five games against the Senators.

In his last 10 games against the Senators, **Tage Thompson** has notched 11 points (9+2).

**Ryan McLeod** has recorded at least one point in all three games he has played against Ottawa as a member of the Sabres and he has tallied six points (1+5) in that span.

**Rasmus Dahlin** has registered eight assists in his last eight games against the Senators, including six assists in his last five contests against Ottawa.

**Jack Quinn** has scored at least one goal in each of his last two games against the Senators.
