THINGS YOU SHOULD KNOW

The Sabres have earned a win in three of their last four home games against the Senators and they have scored four or more goals in each of those wins.

Tage Thompson has registered at least one point in each of his last five home games and he has tallied eight points (4+4) in those games.

In his last five games overall, **Thompson** has recorded seven points (3+4).

Owen Power has recorded six points (1+5) in his last five games, including at least one point in each of his last four home games.

In his last nine games, **Jason Zucker** has posted nine points (3+6), including at least one in each of his last five home games (3+3).

A point in tonight's game would give **Zucker** the longest home point streak of his career (six games). Including his current home point streak of five games, **Zucker** has recorded four five-game home point streaks in his career.

Rasmus Dahlin has notched five points (1+4) in his last four games.

Dahlin is one assist away from tying Doug Bodger for the fourth-most assists by a defenseman in franchise history (233) and is one point away from reaching 300 points in his career.

A SENS OF PURPOSE

JJ Peterka has registered one goal in each of his last two games against the Senators.



A goal in tonight's game would make **Peterka** (22 years, 296 days) the second-youngest Sabres skater to record a goal streak of three or more games against Ottawa.

In his last five games against the Senators, **Tage Thompson** has notched seven points (6+1), including at least one goal in four of the games in that span.

Rasmus Dahlin has posted five points (1+4) in his last five home games against Ottawa.

In two career games against Ottawa, **Devon Levi** has posted a save percentage of .919 and a goals-against average of 2.77.

ON THIS DATE

The Sabres are 12-10-3 all-time on November 5.

November 5, 2006: Drew Stafford makes his NHL debut against the New York Rangers and records an assist on Daniel Briere's game-winning overtime goal, becoming the only player in Sabres history to pick up his first NHL point in the overtime period of his NHL debut.

November 5, 2013: Ryan Miller turns aside 47 shots in a 5-4 shootout victory at San Jose, tying Henrik Lundqvist for the most shootout wins in NHL history (45) at the time.

THE BALANCE OF POWER

Among all NHL defensemen age 25 or younger, **Owen Power** is tied for first in goals (3) and tied for second in points (9).

In that group, **Power** is tied first in even-strength goals (3) and he is tied for second among all NHL defensemen in that category.

Power leads all Sabres defensemen and is tied for fourth among all Sabres skaters in points per game (0.75).

Power's nine even-strength points rank second among all Sabres skaters, trailing only **Tage Thompson** (11).
