TEAM NOTES

- ★ The shootout win tonight marks the first game in the club's fifth back-to-back set of the season (6-2-1 in those games).
- ★ The Blue Jackets scored the first goal of the game for the ninth time this season (7-1-1).
- ★ The Blue Jackets picked up points for the fifth consecutive game overall (3-0-2) as well as at home (4-0-1).
- ★ The Jackets played in their sixth-straight one-goal game since Nov. 8 (3-1-2) and the 10th time in the last 12 contests (6-2-2).
- ★ Columbus scored on the power play for the second-straight game and for the third time in the last four outings (3-of-9, 33.3 pct.).
- ★ CBJ were not whistled for a single penalty for the 20th time in franchise history and the first time since Dec. 19, 2022 vs. Dallas.

PLAYER NOTES

- ★ **C Charlie Coyle** (3-10-13, 19 GP) collected an assist for 1-3-4 in his last four games and has picked up 2-7-9 in his last 10 this season. He now sits two points shy of 500 for his NHL career (192-306-498, 969 GP). He has posted 9-12-21 in 29 career matchups against Montreal with 4-5-9 in his last 10 games overall, and has 7-8-15 in 15 career games played on home ice.

- ★ **C Adam Fantilli** (6-7-13, 19 GP) scored a goal for the fourth time in the last five contests (4-1-5) and has points in five of the last six (4-3-7). He sits six points shy of 100 for his NHL/CBJ career (49-45-94, 150 GP).
- ★ **RW Kirill Marchenko** (8-14-22, 19 GP) extended his career-high points streak to 12 games (3-12-15) with his third multi-point effort (0-2-2) of the campaign. He tied RW Cam Atkinson (12 GP in 2018-19) for the second-longest points streak in franchise history with the effort and trails only Ryan Johansen's 13-game points streak in 2014-15. The run also includes a career-high assist streak of six games started on Nov. 8 (2-7-9). He improved to 2-4-6 in seven career games against Montreal with 1-4-5 in back-to-back outings.
- ★ **RW Mathieu Olivier** (3-6-9, 19 GP) registered an assist for 2-2-4 in his last three games played. He improved to 3-2-5 in nine career games against Montreal with points in three-straight games (1-2-3), while collecting all points in his five career home games.
- ★ **LW Dmitri Voronkov** (8-8-16, 19 GP) notched a power play goal for the second-straight game and notched his fourth multi-point effort of the campaign with 1-1-2. He has recorded 3-3-6 in seven career matchups against the Canadiens, with 3-1-4 in his last three matchups as well as 3-2-5 in four career games played at Nationwide Arena.
- ★ **D Zach Werenski** (5-10-15, 19 GP) notched his team-leading fifth multi-point effort of the season with 1-1-2 to stretch his points streak to three-straight games (1-3-4). He sits one point shy of 400 for his NHL/CBJ career (118-281-399, 586 GP). He improved to 4-14-18 in 22 career games against Montreal with 2-6-8 in his last four consecutive games. He has picked up 3-12-15 in his last 13 games against the Canadiens, including 2-6-8 in his last four at Nationwide Arena.
