PLAYER NOTES

- **Matthew Knies** scored the game-winning goal for Toronto at 2:26 of overtime. Knies scored his second goal of the playoffs and the first overtime goal of his Stanley Cup playoff career.
- **Jake McCabe** scored for the Maple Leafs at 5:33 of the first period. McCabe scored the first goal of his Stanley Cup playoff career. McCabe tied a single-game Stanley Cup playoff career-high with seven hits registered tonight.
- **Mitch Marner** recorded the primary assist on McCabe’s goal, posting his second assist of the playoffs. Marner recorded the 39th assist of his Stanley Cup playoff career, claiming sole possession of third on the franchise all-time list for most assists recorded during the playoffs, passing Mats Sundin and Red Kelly. With the assist, Marner also recorded the 50th point of his Stanley Cup playoff career (11G, 39A). Per NHL Stats, “Marner became the 12th player in franchise history with 50 career playoff points. Marner became the fourth-fastest player in Maple Leafs history to record 50 career playoff points, trailing Doug Gilmour (31 GP), Darryl Sittler (47 GP) and Mats Sundin (53 GP).” Marner has recorded a point in three-consecutive games (1G, 2A).
- **Max Domi** registered the secondary assist on McCabe’s goal, posting his third assist of the playoffs. Domi has recorded four points (1G, 3A) through his last four games.
- **John Tavares** recorded the primary assist on Knies’ goal, posting his first assist of the 2024 Stanley Cup Playoffs. Tavares set a new single-game Stanley Cup playoff career-high with six hits registered tonight.
- **Ilya Lyubushkin** posted the secondary assist on Knies’ goal, recording his third assist of the playoffs. Lyubushkin has registered an assist in back-to-back games.
- **Max Domi** set a new single-game Stanley Cup playoff career-high with 12 face-off wins tonight.
- **Joseph Woll** stopped 27 of 28 shots he faced in tonight’s win. Per NHL Stats, “Woll earned his second career win in potential series-elimination games and tied Gord McRae, Felix Potvin and John Ross Roach for the most by a rookie goaltender in franchise history.”
- **Morgan Rielly** was on the ice for a team-high 34 Toronto shot attempts-for at 5-on-5.
- **Morgan Rielly** finished the game with a team-high 5-on-5 shot attempt percentage of 68.00 percent (34 for, 16 against).

TEAM NOTES

- The Maple Leafs are 63-62-1 in playoff overtime games, including 25-27 as the road team.
- The Maple Leafs were 0-for-3 on the power play and 1-for-1 on the penalty kill tonight.
- Per NHL Stats, “The Maple Leafs have forced a Game 6 after facing a 3-1 deficit in a best-of-seven series for the seventh time in franchise history, with the two most-recent instances also coming against the Bruins (2018 & 2013).”
