Sidney Crosby scored the first two Penguins goals on Saturday against Montreal, with his second standing as the game-winning goal.

- Crosby scored the game-winning goal for the second-consecutive game and has three total on the season. No player in the league has more game winners than Crosby this season:

## OFFENSIVE DEFENSEMEN

Defensemen Kris Letang and Erik Karlsson have been red hot in their careers against the New York Islanders, recording 49 and 25 points, respectively.

- Letang leads all active defensemen with 13 goals and 49 points in 71 games against the Islanders, while Karlsson ranks third with 25 points in 35 games:

## HEY NOW, YOU'RE THE THIRD STAR

Penguins Captain Sidney Crosby was named the NHL's Third Star of the Week ending November 3 after recording seven points (4G-3A) in the team's three games over the past week.

- Crosby's four goals and seven points led the Penguins over the past week, with his goals and points ranking second and fifth in the league, respectively.
- Over the past week, Crosby recorded multiple points in three-consecutive games and factored into seven-straight team goals. This tied the most consecutive team goals he has scored/assisted on in his career:

- The last Penguin to factor in on seven-consecutive team goals was Kris Letang from Jan. 27-30, 2015.
- Crosby also scored four-straight Penguins goals from Oct. 31 against Anaheim through his second goal on Nov. 2 versus Montreal, which marked the third time in his career he has scored four-consecutive team goals:

Sidney Crosby enters tonight's game just three goals away from becoming the 21st player in NHL history to score 600 career goals.

- Crosby is set join Mario Lemieux (690) as the only two Penguins to score 600 goals with the franchise.
- He will become just the seventh player in NHL history to score 600 career goals with one team:
