#### HEY NOW, YOU'RE THE THIRD STAR

Penguins Captain Sidney Crosby was named the NHL's Third Star of the Week ending November 3 after recording seven points [4G-3A] in the team's three games over the past week.

- Crosby's four goals and seven points led the Penguins over the past week, with his goals and points ranking second and fifth in the league, respectively.
- Over the past week, Crosby recorded multiple points in three-consecutive games and factored into seven-straight team goals. This tied the most consecutive team goals he has scored/assisted on in his career:
