PRACTICE UPDATE:

- Prior to their flight to Denver, the Stars will hold media availability with forward **Tyler Seguin** and head coach **Pete DeBoer** at approximately 1 p.m. CT at **Signature Flight Support - Terminal 3** (8321 Lemmon Ave, Dallas, Texas 75209) on Friday, May 10.

NOTES

- With two goals, **Miro Heiskanen** (2-0—2) scored his second tally of the game and matched the franchise mark for most goals in a playoff by a defenseman. Heiskanen, who also scored twice in Game 2 of the 2020 First Round, joined **Sergei Zubov** as the only other defenseman in franchise history with two multi-goal performances in the playoffs. Heiskanen joined **Brian Glynn** (Game 4 of 1991 DF) as the second defenseman in franchise history with two power-play goals in a playoff game. The last defenseman league-wide with two power-play goals in a game was **Dougie Hamilton** (Game 3 of 2019 R1).

- Forward **Roope Hintz** (1-3—4) recorded his second career four-point game in the postseason (also 1-3—4 in Game 2 of 2023 R1). Only three other players in franchise history have posted multiple four-point games in the playoffs: **Bobby Smith** (3 GP), **Miro Heiskanen** (2 GP) and **Dino Ciccarelli** (2 GP).

- Forward **Tyler Seguin** (1-0—1) tallied his first career postseason shorthanded goal to put the Stars up 4-0 in the second period. It came in his 123rd career postseason contest.

- Defenseman Esa Lindell (1-0-1) scored his third career playoff goal.

- Forward Jason Robertson (0-1—1) registered his fourth assist of the playoffs. Robertson has points (0-2—2) in each of the first two games vs. Colorado and seven points (3-4—7) in nine games thus far.

- Captain **Jamie Benn** (0-1—1) recorded his fourth assist of the playoffs to give him three points (1-2—3) in two games in this series.

- Defenseman Nils Lundkvist (0-1-1) picked up his first career playoff point with an assist.

- Goaltender Jake Oettinger made 28 saves on 31 shots for his fifth victory of the postseason.
