FLAMES LAST GAME RECAP November 29, 2024 – CALGARY FLAMES [2] vs. COLUMBUS BLUE JACKETS [5]

Game Summary I Event Summary

The Calgary Flames continued a four-game road trip on Friday afternoon in Columbus. The home side would fine themselves up 2-0 through 20 courtesy of goals from Adam Fantilli and Kent Johnson. In the second, Columbus extended their lead to three, before Blake Coleman got Calgary on the board and drew the visitors within two heading into the final frame. In the third, Columbus again extended their lead, but Nazem Kadri would strike on the power play to bring the Flames within two again. The Jackets would add an empty netter to knock off Calgary 5-2.

TONIGHTS STORYLINES & STATS

This is the second of two meetings this season between the Flames and Penguins. Calgary knocked off Pittsburgh 4-3 in a shootout in their first matchup on October 22nd.

This is a Pacific Division versus Metropolitan Division matchup; the Flames have a record of 5-2-0 against Metropolitan Division teams and a record of 6-3-3 against Eastern Conference opponents.

FIRST MEETING:

The Calgary Flames welcomed the Pittsburgh Penguins to the Scotiabank Saddledome back on October 22nd for their first of two meetings. Calgary struck first with Rasmus Andersson scoring the opening-frame's only marker to give the homeside a 1-0 advantage. In the second, Bryan Rust leveled things for Pittsburgh to knot this game at one a piece through 40. Pittsburgh would take their first lead 2:32 into the third before MacKenzie Weegar blasted a point-shot home to tie things at two. The Penguins would once again take the lead, but with under a minute left in regulation and the net empty, the Flames would draw level after Nazem Kadri buried his then-third of the season and forced overtime. The extra frame solved nothing, and in a shootout, Justin Kirkland converted in the sixth round followed by Dustin Wolf denying Evgeni Malkin to give the Flames a 4-3 victory.

HANLEY MAN:

Flames blueliner Joel Hanley skated in his 199th NHL game yesterday in Columbus, and is just one game away from 200 in his NHL career. Hanley can become the 17th-active undrafted defenceman to reach 200 games in their NHL career. The Keswick, ON native made his NHL debut on March 20th, 2016 against Calgary as a member of the Montreal Canadiens, and has spent time with Montreal, Arizona, Dallas, and Calagry through his 199-previous NHL games.

KIRKLAND SIGNATURE:

In Calgary and Pittsburgh's first meeting on October 22, Justin Kirkland scored the game-deciding goal in his first ever NHL shootout attempt. Kirkland is tied with an NHL-best three shootout goals and has a shootout percentage of 75% in his NHL career. In the AHL, Kirkland posted a 62.9 shootout-percentage, going 22/35 through eight American Hockey League campaigns.

BACK-TO-BACKS:

Following their 5-2 setback in Columbus yesterday, the Flames are set to complete their third back-to-back set of the 2024-25 season. In the Flames last set, they split the two contests on Nov. 11 vs. LAK (3-1 W) and Nov. 12 at VAN (1-3 L). Calgary has a 3-2-0 record in back-to-back games so far this season, and following their game in Pittsburgh tomorrow night, Calgary's next back-to-back will come on Dec. 28 and Dec. 29 when they face San Jose and Vegas on the road.

RAZZLE DAZZLE:

Rasmus Andersson enters play tonight with a team-leading 75 blocked shots so far in 2024-25. As of Nov. 29, Andersson's 75 blocks lead all skaters in the NHL so far this season, and since the start of 2023-24, the only player on the Flames to block more shots is MacKenzie Weegar (264).

LOOK BACKS AT IT:

Mikael Backlund enters play tonight with 102 road goals in his NHL career, tied with Lanny McDonald for the fifth-most in Flames franchise history. With one more goal, Backlund can take soul-possession of fifth spot and the only players to score more road goals for the Flames are: Jarome Iginla (257), Theo Fleury (160), Joe Nieuwendyk (135), and Gary Roberts (110). Backlund leads all Swedish-born skaters in Flames franchise history in goals away from home, with Hakan Loob (96), and Kent Nilsson (87) sitting second and third respectively.

HEY DID YOU KNOW?

Matt Coronato scored his first NHL goal in Pittsburgh against the Penguins in Calgary's last trip to PPG Paints Arena back on October 14th, 2023.

In these clubs first meeting on Oct. 22 in Calgary, the Flames earned a win after scoring a tying goal in the final minute of regulation for the first time since April 26, 2022.

Dustin Wolf recorded his second-career NHL assist on Nazem Kadri's third period marker yesterday in Columbus.
