



Nashville Predators Summer Hockey Camps Frequently Asked Questions

What summer hockey camps do the Nashville Predators offer?

The Nashville Predators and the Ford Ice Centers will offer three different summer camps in 2026! Players of all ages, skills, and positions have a camp offering designed for them to continue developing their skills during the off-season.

Nashville Predators Hockey School– June 22-26, 2026

- Hosted at Ford Ice Center Bellevue

Nashville Predators Hockey School– July 13-17, 2026

- Hosted at Ford Ice Center Antioch

Nashville Predators Goaltending Camp – July 20-23, 2026

- Hosted at Ford Ice Center Bellevue

Does my child need to know how to skate? What skill level does my child need to have?

Each of our summer hockey camps is different and specifically tailored for the following players. Players will need to have completed some level of hockey programming prior to the start of their camp. These camps are not appropriate for a new skater.

Nashville Predators Hockey School

For players and goalies, ages 6 through 14, that have participated in Little Preds Continue to Play, Tri-Star Hockey League and/or similar in-house recreational league, and A travel teams.

Nashville Predators Goaltending Camp

For goalies, ages 6 through 17, that have completed at least one season of Youth League or travel hockey as a full-time goaltender.

What equipment does my child need? Is rental equipment available?

Participants will need to provide his/her own hockey equipment to participate. We are unable to provide rental equipment or skates. Necessary equipment includes a helmet

with face mask, mouth guard, neck guard, shoulder pads, elbow pads, gloves, protective hockey pants, athletic support cup, shin guards, hockey socks, skates, and stick. Goaltenders will need to provide full goalie equipment.

Who are the instructors for the summer camps?

Our camps will be led by qualified instructors that will include Nashville Predators Youth Hockey Development staff, Nashville area hockey coaches and members of the hockey community with backgrounds in semi-pro and/or college hockey.

What is the cost for each camp?

Nashville Predators Hockey School

Birth years 2018-2020: \$575 *plus tax*

Birth years 2012-2017: \$650 *plus tax*

Nashville Predators Goaltending Camp

\$700 *plus tax*

Do we allow payment plans?

Yes, we allow payment plans of 2 payments to complete the cost of registration. Half is due upon registration, and the remaining balance is due **June 1**. Players will not be allowed to participate without full payment.

What is included with registration?

Participants will receive an official Nashville Predators summer camp jersey, camp t-shirt, giveaways, and more. Each camper will also receive a daily lunch according to the camp schedule – the menu will be sent out in camper packets closer to the start of camp.

What is the cancelation policy?

The Nashville Predators summer hockey camps offer a **NO REFUND** policy. In the event of documented medical issue, we will provide a full refund. All other refund requests will be handled on a case-by-case basis and may be subject to a partial refund.

Do the summer hockey camps sell out? Is a waitlist offered?

Yes! To avoid disappointment be sure to [register online](#) today. Once the camps sell out, we will begin a waitlist.

As we are notified of cancelations, we will contact families for the opportunity to register – first come, first serve.

What does a typical schedule consist of?

Each camp is different – but campers can expect to have multiple ice touches, dryland, lunch, and classroom activities daily.

Prior to the start of camp, you will receive a camp packet with a detailed schedule breakdown by age group.

Once I register my child, what will happen next?

Once your registration and payment are processed, you will receive a confirmation e-mail. We will send an orientation packet with some paperwork that needs to be completed prior to camp.

What does my child need to bring to camp?

In addition to hockey equipment, participants should also bring: a change of clothes for dryland training including sneakers, hat and sunscreen for outdoor activities, a change of clothes to wear under hockey equipment, a water bottle, and snacks throughout the day.

Will there be an orientation for parents? Is any paperwork needed to participate?

We will not hold a formal orientation for parents. Staff will be visible and on-hand the first day of each camp and throughout the week for questions. On the first day of each week, campers will check-in to pick up their jersey and t-shirt and to meet instructors.

All participants will receive an orientation packet via email with paperwork that will have to be filled out and sent back prior to camp.
