AT A GLANCE

AWAY TEAM'S CRYPTO-NITE

Following back-to-back 7-2 victories over the Carolina Hurricanes on March 22 and Boston Bruins on March 23, the Kings swept their three-game homestand with a 3-1 comeback win over the NY Rangers on Tuesday. With the victories over a trio of teams that have made a combined five appearances in the last five Eastern Conference finals, the Kings extended their home point streak to 15 games (12-0-3), marking the longest such streak in team history. Tuesday's win marked the team's 26th victory at home (26-3-4), matching a franchise best home win total set four times previously, most recently in 2022-23. As part of their homestand, the Kings scored 14 goals in their back-to-back set against the Hurricanes and Bruins to mark the 17th time in franchise history, and first since April 1 & 3, 1995, the team scored seven goals in back-to-back games.

FIFTY-FIVE BIG BOOMS

Forward **Quinton Byfield** enters tonight's contest fresh off his career-long nine-game home point streak to (7-7=14; Feb. 24 – March 23). Byfield picked up his 19th goal and 25th helper of the season (1-1=2) on Sunday night as part of his second consecutive multi-point game (1-1=2 on Mar. 22 vs. CAR). It stands as the longest home point streak by a player under 23 years of age since **Luc Robitaille's** 10-game run (6-9=15) in 1988-89. Overall, he is just the sixth player to establish a home point streak of at least nine games before turning 23 years old in LA Kings history: **Jimmy Carson** (x3), **Steve Duchesne**, **Larry Murphy** (x2), **Bernie Nicholls** (x2) and Robitaille (x3).

THE KUEMPIRE STREAK'S BACK

Goaltender **Darcy Kuemper** turned aside 22 of 23 shots faced in Tuesday's win against the Rangers to extend his home point streak to 15 games (14-0-1), dating to Dec. 7, 2024. After passing **Kelly Hruddy** for sole possession of the franchise record earlier this month, Kuemper is also the first Canadian-born goaltender
