

## ARTY PARTY

Goaltender Arturs Silovs has earned the Penguins points in 12 of his last 15 games, going 10-3-2 dating back to December 21.

- Silovs recorded his second shutout of the season in the team's first matchup against the Vegas Golden Knights, stopping all 22 shots on March 1.
- Silovs has won six of his last eight games and has given up two goals or less in seven of his last 11 starts, recording a 2.19 goals-against average and .919 save percentage in that span.
