PRACTICE UPDATE:

The Dallas Stars will host the Dallas Stars Hall of Fame Induction Gala presented by Truist beginning at 5 p.m. at Gilley's Southside Ballroom (1135 Botham Jean Blvd., Dallas, TX 75215). NOTES:

- Forward **Wyatt Johnston** had a career-best three-point performance (1-2—3) in Dallas' 5-4 overtime victory over Philadelphia. Johnston opened the scoring with his first goal of the season at the 4:02 mark of the first period and earned the lone assist on Joe Pavelski's game-winning tally. Johnston was tied for the most goals among rookies last season with 24 (w/ Seattle's Matty Beniers).
- Forward **Joe Pavelski** (452) passed Patrick Kane (451) for sole possession of sixth place on the NHL's all-time goals list among U.S.-born skaters with his game-winning goal in OT vs. Philadelphia. It also represented his 72nd career game-winning goal, tying Keith Tkachuk and Brian Rolston for sixth most by a U.S.-born skater.
- Pavelski's point streak reached three consecutive games (3-2—5) with a goal and an assist against Philadelphia. Pavelski leads the team with five points through the first four games of the 2023-24 season.
- Captain **Jamie Benn** picked up his first multi-point game of the season with a goal and an assist (1-1—2) vs. the Flyers.
- Forward **Roope Hintz** (1-0—1) scored for the second consecutive game, pushing his point streak to three consecutive games (2-1—3) since his season debut on Oct. 17 at Vegas.
- Forward **Tyler Seguin** (1-0—1) lit the lamp for the first time this season and extended his point streak to three consecutive games (1-2—3).
- Forward **Jason Robertson** extended his point streak to two games (0-2—2) with an assist Saturday vs. Philadelphia.
- After tying his career high for points in a game (3) two nights ago in Anaheim, defenseman **Miro Heiskanen** picked up an assist vs. Philadelphia to give him four points in his past two games (1-3—4).
- Making his season debut, goaltender **Scott Wedgewood** stopped 36 of 40 shots.
