KINGS NOTES

- Forward **Alex Turcotte** (1-0=1) scored his second goal of the season, and has now picked up three points (1-2=3) over his last four games. Turcotte now has points in back-to-back games against the Ducks (1A; Oct. 20, 2024).
- Forward **Alex Laferriere** (1-1=2) notched his 10th goal and ninth assist of the season for his second-straight multi-point effort (0-2=2 on Nov. 27), establishing the first such streak of his career. Laferriere now has three points (2-1=3) in his last two games against the Ducks (1G; Oct. 20, 2024).
- Laferriere's goal stood as the game-winner, his second straight deciding tally against the Ducks (Oct. 20, 2024), becoming the third skater in franchise history to score the game-winning goal in back-to-back games against Anaheim, joining **Joe Corvo** (Jan. 24, 2004 & Jan. 28, 2024) and **Anze Kopitar** (March 10, 2021 & April 20, 2021).
- Forward **Phillip Danault** (0-1=1) tallied his 10th assist of the season, his 100th as a member of the Kings. Danault becomes the eighth Quebec-born skater to tally 100 assists as an LA King, and is the second skater to record his 100th helper in a Kings sweater so far this season, joining **Trevor Moore** (Nov. 13, 2024 at COL).
- Defenseman **Brandt Clarke** (0-1=1) picked up his 13th assist of the season to push his point streak to a third game (1-2=3), dating back to Nov. 25. Clarke's 16 points (3-13=16) this season are the most by a blueliner selected in the 2021 NHL Draft.
- Captain Anze Kopitar skated in his 700th career road game today, the fourth most among all active skaters behind Ryan Suter (728), Alex Ovechkin (725), and Brent Burns (714).
- Goaltender **Erik Portillo** made his NHL regular season debut, stopping 30 of 31 shots faced to secure his first career victory. Portillo is the third Swedish-born goaltender to play for the Kings. He is also the first University of Michigan Wolverines goaltender alumnus—and ninth player overall—to appear in a game for the franchise.
