MATCHUP NOTES

- ★ Columbus has won five of the last seven games of the series since Apr. 24, 2022.
- ★ The home team has recorded points in nine-straight meetings dating back to Mar. 7, 2020 (8-0-1).
- ★ The winning teams have won by a margin of three goals or more in 11 of the last 14 games of the series and by multiple goals in 16 of the last 18 meetings since Feb. 2, 2016.
- ★ The winning team has scored four or more goals in 13 of the last 14 games of the series, including five consecutive.
- ★ The teams have combined for seven-plus goals in five of the past eight games of the series.
- ★ C Sean Monahan has posted 14-13-27 in 45 career games against Edmonton and has notched three goals in his last three meetings.
- ★ D Zach Werenski has registered 1-7-8 in 12 career outings, including points in five of his past six contests (1-4-5).



JACKET TO WATCH - C Cole Sillinger

Has tallied 3-6-9 with 3 mutli-point efforts in 8 career GP against the Oilers. Posted goals and multiple points in both games in 2024-25 (2-3-5) and has assists in three-straight contests (2-4-6).





OILER TO WATCH - C Connor McDavid

Has tallied 9-25-34 with 10 multi-point efforts in 18 career GP against CBJ. Has recorded 3-7-10 in the past 5 meetings and has at least one point in 8 of 9 career games at Rogers Place (5-12-17).



TEAM NOTES

- ★ CBJ closes out their five-game road trip with a back-to-back set at Edmonton on Monday and Seattle on Tuesday. The club fell 4-3 at Vancouver in its most recent outing on Saturday.
- ★ The Blue Jackets, who play 15 back-to-back sets this season, are 4-2-0 through their first three and are 2-1-0 in both the first and second contests. The team has won two-straight opening games of a back-to-back set.
- ★ Monday's game at Edmonton begins a stretch of six games in nine days for Columbus through Nov. 18.
- ★ CBJ blueliners have recorded 11-16-27 in 14 games and enter Sunday's games leading the league in goals scored and percentage of team goals (25.6).

PLAYER NOTES

- * C Adam Fantilli registered his third multi-point effort of the season with two assists on Saturday.
- * RW Kirill Marchenko has tied his career-best points streak (4-9-13; Dec. 14-27, 2024) with points in seven-straight games (3-6-9) after recording points on all three CBJ goals on Saturday (2-1-3). He has registered points in 12 of the 14 games in 2025-26 (8-8-16) and leads the team in goals, assists, points and shots on goals (tied, 51).
- * D Denton Mateychuk has collected points in each of his last three games played (1-2-3) and five of his past eight (3-2-5).
- ★ LW **Dmitri Voronkov** posted his second career three-point outing with 1-2-3 against Vancouver on Saturday. He ranks second on the team in goals, assists (tied) and points with 6-7-13 in 14 appearances in 2025-26.
- ★ D Zach Werenski enters Sunday's games ranking second in the NHL in TOI/GP (26:22) as well as first among league blueliners in shots on goal (51).

BROADCAST NOTE

HHOF Announcer John Davidson joins the Blue Jackets television broadcast as an analyst for Monday's contest at Edmonton. He currently serves as a senior advisor and alternate governor for the club after previously serving as the club's president of hockey operations for two stints.
