THINGS YOU SHOULD KNOW

In his last 17 games, **Casey Mittelstadt** has registered 17 points (6+11).

Rasmus Dahlin has recorded nine points (3+6) in his last nine games.

Dylan Cozens has registered one point in back-to-back games (1+1) and a point in tonight's game would give him a three-game point streak.

A point in tonight's game would give **Cozens** his second point streak of three or more games in 2023-24 (Oct. 17 to 27; six games; 3+4).

Jordan Greenway has tallied three points (2+1) in his last four games, including two points (1+1) last night at Anaheim.



KING ME

Victor Olofsson has recorded four points (1+3) in his last two games against the Kings and a point in tonight's game would give him a three-game point streak against Los Angeles.

In four games against the Kings in his career, **Dylan Cozens** has registered four points (1+3), including a goal in the last matchup between Buffalo and Los Angeles.

In his last six games against the Kings, **Alex Tuch** has tallied six points (3+3), including two multi-point performances in that span.



Casey Mittelstadt has notched five points (2+3) in his last four games against Los Angeles.

Peyton Krebs has recorded a goal in back-to-back games against the Kings.

With a goal in tonight's game, **Krebs** would become the first Sabres skater since Dave Andreychuk from Feb. 8, 1991 to Oct. 7, 2000 (six games) to record a goal streak of three or more games against Los Angeles.

ON THIS DATE

The Sabres are 13-8-0 all-time on January 24.

January 24, 1978: The Sabres host the NHL All-Star Game at Buffalo Memorial Auditorium. Sabres forward Rick Martin scores to tie the game late in the third period and Gilbert Perreault scores the game-winning goal in overtime.

January 24, 1981: Twelve Sabres get on the scoresheet, led by Danny Gare's two-goal night, as the Sabres defeat the Capitals 7-4 in Washington.

January 24, 2013: Drew Stafford plays in his 400th NHL game.

January 24, 2023: **Tage Thompson** records three points (1+2) and **Jeff Skinner** and **Alex Tuch** each register one goal and one assist in a 5-3 win over St. Louis.

SO FRESH, SO DAHLIN

Rasmus Dahlin leads all NHL defensemen in goals (13) and he ranks seventh among all NHL defensemen in points.

Dahlin is on pace to record 23 goals in 2023-24, which would be the most by a Sabres defenseman since Phil Housley recorded 26 goals in 1988-89.

He currently leads all Sabres skaters in power-play points (13) and time on ice per game (25:00).

Dahlin ranks second among all Sabres skaters in assists (25) and points (38).
