TEAM NOTES

- ★ The Blue Jackets' overtime win tonight snapped a five-game winless streak since Dec. 6 (0-4-1).
- ★ Columbus and Anaheim kicked off the two-game season series tonight and face off again on Saturday in California.
- ★ The teams played in their third-straight overtime game at Nationwide Arena and for the seventh time in the last 10 in Ohio since Feb. 11, 2016.
- ★ CBJ skated in their 21st one-goal game of the season (63.6 – 1-goal game pct.) and are 10-5-6 in those games.
- ★ The Jackets scored first for the 17th time overall this season (10-3-4) and the ninth time at Nationwide Arena (6-2-1).
- ★ Columbus shut out Anaheim on the penalty kill tonight (4-for-4) and has now gone 46-of-46 on the PK in the last 18 games of the series (24-of-24 in last 10 at Nationwide Arena).
- ★ Columbus' second and third goals of the game were tallied 19 seconds apart for the fastest two goals scored this season (31 seconds, Voronkov 10:24 and Wood 10:57 of 2nd period, Dec. 6 at Florida).

PLAYER NOTES

- ★ RW **Yegor Chinakhov** (3-3-6, 27 GP) notched an assist on Werenski's goal for points in back-to-back games (1-1-2) and now has points in all three career games against Anaheim (2-1-3).

- ★ **C Adam Fantilli** (12-10-22, 33 GP) scored the second overtime game winning goal of the campaign and career tonight. The goal marked his sixth career game-winning goal which is the second most among Blue Jackets players since making his debut in 2023-24, behind only Mathieu Olivier (7).
- ★ **C Brendan Gaunce** (1-3-4, 12 GP) collected an assist on Werenski's second goal of the game.
- ★ **G Jet Greaves** (8-8-5) posted 24 saves tonight and has stopped 338-of-371 shots (.911 SV%, 2.53 GAA) in his last 13 games played this season.
- ★ **C Boone Jenner** (5-9-14, 19 GP) scored and assisted tonight (1-1-2) for his fifth multi-point performance of the season and has notched 2-2-4 in three contests since returning from injury on Dec. 11 with two multi-point outings.
- ★ **LW Kent Johnson** (3-7-10, 32 GP) posted two assists tonight for his second multi-point performance of the season (1st multi-assist) and has collected assists in the last three games (0-4-4).
- ★ **D Ivan Provorov** (4-8-12, 33 GP) tallied the lone assist on Jenner's goal for his first point since Dec. 4.
- ★ **D Zach Werenski** (11-24-35, 33 GP) notched his fourth three-point effort of the season tonight with two goals and a assist on the OT GWG to stretch his home points streak to 11 consecutive games since Oct. 29 (7-13-20). It is the second-longest home points streak in franchise history behind his own 22-game streak set last season from Nov. 1, 2024-Feb. 22, 2025 (14-27-41). Werenski, who scored his 10th of the campaign with his first tally, has notched double-digit goals in eight seasons and is tied with Washington's John Carlson for the most among active American blueliners. He skated in his 600th career game tonight (124-296-420), surpassing Nick Foligno (599) for the fourth-most in franchise history. With his 2-1-3 performance, he improved his career mark against Anaheim to 8-5-13 in 15 career games with points in four-straight meetings (4-3-7).
