SHUTTING THE DOOR

Since the NHL's holiday break concluded on December 27, the Penguins have points in eight of their last 10 games due in large part to the play of the goaltenders and defensemen.

- The Penguins have limited their opponents to a league-best 20 goals against since the NHL's holiday break. In that span, the team's 2.00 goals-against average leads the league, while their .921 save percentage ranks second:

STREAKIN' VS. CBJ

Pittsburgh enters tonight's game with points in 18-consecutive home games against the Columbus Blue Jackets dating back to December 21, 2015.

- Pittsburgh's 18-game home point streak against Columbus is the longest active home point streak against one team in the NHL:

- During Pittsburgh's 18-game home point streak against Columbus, they have outscored them 74-40. In 18 games, the Penguins have scored three-plus goals in all but one game and four-plus goals in 13 games.

POWERED UP

Pittsburgh went 3-for-4 on the power-play on Thursday night against Philadelphia and improved their success rate to 29.4% on the season.

- The Penguins' 29.4% conversion rate on the power play ranks second across the entire league this season.
- Sidney Crosby, who scored his 10th power-play goal on Thursday, leads all Eastern Conference skaters and ranks fifth in the league in power-play goals.
