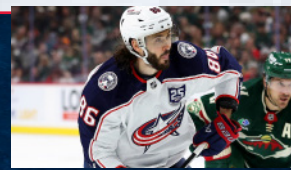
MATCHUP NOTES

- ★ Columbus won the 2024-25 season series (3-1-0) for the first time since 2017-18 (also 3-1-0).
- ★ CBJ snapped a six-game road losing streak in the series (0-5-1) in the most recent contest at UBS Arena on Mar. 24, 2025 (4-3 SOW).
- ★ The winning team has won by a multiple goals in six of the last seven meetings overall.
- ★ The teams have combined for six-plus goals in five of the past seven contests played at New York.
- ★ The Blue Jackets killed off 6-of-7 Islanders power play attempts in the 2024-25 season series (85.7 pct.).
- ★ G **Elvis Merzlikins** (26 saves) notched CBJ's fifth and most recent shutout in the series on Oct. 30, 2024 (2-0 CBJ W).
- ★ C **Sean Monahan** has totaled 6-11-17 in 20 career GP against NYI and has 2-6-8 with 3 multi-point efforts in last 6 GP.
- ★ C **Cole Sillinger** has notched assists in three of his past four games against the Islanders (1-3-4).



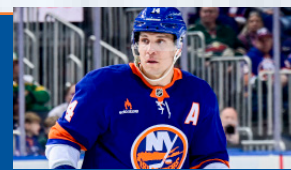
JACKET TO WATCH - RW Kirill Marchenko

Has tallied 2-3-5 in 8 career GP against the Islanders. Has tallied
points in 3-straight meetings (1-2-3) and 4 of the past 5 (2-3-5).
Recorded points in both GP at NYI in 2024-25 (1-1-2).



ISLANDER TO WATCH - C Bo Horvat

Has tallied 12-10-22 with 6 multi-point efforts in 23 career GP.
Has totaled 8-9-17 with 5 multi-point outings in 11 career home
contests, including 6-6-12 in last 5 GP at home.



TEAM NOTES

- ★ Columbus won its fourth-straight game and for the sixth time in the past seven contests after earning a 3-2 victory over St. Louis on Saturday.
- ★ CBJ close out their third consecutive back-to-back set on Sunday at the NY Islanders. The club is 4-1-0 in back-to-back sets, including 2-0-0 in the second game this season.
- ★ The Blue Jackets scored in all three periods for the fourth-straight game and sixth time this season on Saturday and have scored in 25-of-the-33 periods played in regulation in 2025-26.
- ★ CBJ, who have won four-straight road contests, play nine of the next 12 games away from Nationwide Arena from Nov. 2-24, including a five-game road trip from Nov. 2-11.
- ★ CBJ lead the NHL in goals and goal percentage by defensemen with 10-15-25 and 27.0 pct. in the first 11 games.

PLAYER NOTES

- ★ C **Charlie Coyle** notched a goal on Saturday and has posted points in five of the past seven contests (2-6-8).
- ★ Goaltenders **Jet Greaves** (2.67 GAA, .916 SV% in 6 GP) and **Elvis Merzlikins** (2.97 GAA, .915 SV% in 5 GP) have each registered a .915 SV% or better. The Jackets rank third in the league with a team save percentage of .911, trailing only Winnipeg (.918) and Pittsburgh (.915).
- ★ RW **Kirill Marchenko** collected an assist on Saturday and has points in nine of the 11 games this season (5-6-11).
- ★ C **Sean Monahan** posted the game-winning goal for his 600th career point (264-336-600, 829 GP) against the Blues. He became the fourth player from the 2013 NHL Draft class to reach the mark, joining C Nathan MacKinnon (1,034 points), C Aleksander Barkov (782 points) and C Elias Lindholm (613 points).
- ★ F **Cole Sillinger** has points in two-straight (2-2-4) and three of the last four contests (2-3-5).
- ★ D **Zach Werenski** (4-6-10, 11 GP) has notched 1-1-2 in three-straight contests. It's tied for the longest multi-point streak by a defenseman in CBJ history, set by Seth Jones (4-3-7; Mar. 8-12, 2018) and matched by Werenski (2-4-6; Nov. 27-Dec. 1, 2024).
