

BOSTON BRUINS TEACHER LOUNGE MAKEOVER CONTEST

OFFICIAL CONTEST RULES

1. Sponsors and Administrator: BOSTON BRUINS TEACHER LOUNGE MAKEOVER ("Contest") is sponsored by Wellpoint ("Sponsor") and administered by the Boston Professional Hockey Association, Inc. ("Administrator").

2. General: The Contest begins on Monday, March 3, 2025, and runs until Friday, March 14, 2025 (collectively the "Contest Period"). One (1) winner will be chosen from all eligible entries on March 28, 2025. The odds of winning a prize depend on the total number of eligible entries received during the Contest Period (each an "Entry"). Administrator cannot accurately predict the number of entrants who will participate in the Contest (each an "Entrant"). All times in this Contest refer to Eastern Time. By participating in the Contest, the Entrant acknowledges and agrees to be bound by these Official Rules, and agrees that all decisions of Administrator, whose decisions are in its sole discretion, are binding and final. Failure to comply with these Official Rules will result in disqualification from the Contest.

3. Eligibility: The Contest is open only to Entrants who are legal U.S. residents of MA who are at least 18 years of age as of Monday, March 3, 2025. Void where prohibited. Employees of Sponsor, Administrator, Delaware North Companies, Inc. - Boston ("DNCB"), TD Bank, New England Sports Network ("NESN"), and their respective parent companies, subsidiaries and affiliates, and the officers, directors, agents, employees, advertising and promotion agencies and members of their immediate families (spouses, parents, children, and siblings and their spouses) of each of the foregoing are ineligible to enter.

By entering this Contest, Entrants agree to these Official Rules and the decisions of the Administrator, which are binding and final in all matters relating to this Contest.

6. Determination of Winners: One (1) winner will be selected by a panel of judges from the Sponsor and Administrator. The winner will be the Entry that has the best answer to the question "Why should the school be picked for a teacher lounge makeover?" as decided by Sponsor and Administrator's panel of judges. Administrator will notify the winner by March 28, 2025 via the email provided in the Contest Entry form, and the Winner will be required to provide written consent of release giving Administrator the irrevocable right without any further notice, review or consent to print, publish, broadcast, distribute, and use his or her photo, name and biographical information as news, publicity or information without any further compensation.

If any prize notification is undeliverable, if the winner is not responsive within 24 hours of the initial notification, or in the event of non-compliance with any of these requirements, the prize will be forfeited, and an alternate Winner will be selected from the remaining pool of eligible Entries.
