Victor Mancini made his NHL debut on October 9, 2024 in Pittsburgh less than a year after completing his junior season at the University of Nebraska-Omaha. He agreed to a two-year contract with the Rangers on April 2, 2024 and played in seven contests with Hartford, notching three points (0G, 3A). The 6-foot-3, 229-pound defenseman also appeared in 10 Calder Cup Playoff contests, tallying three assists. Prior to college, Mancini split the 2020-21 campaign with the Green Bay Gamblers (USHL), Hanhals IF in HockeyEttan, Sweden's third-tier league, and Frolunda's junior U20 team.
