AT A GLANCE

FIALAWEEN

Forward **Kevin Fiala** (0-1=1) notched his fourth assist of the season on Thursday night against the Red Wings and now has 497 points (216-281=497) over his 663 career games played. The native of St. Gallen, Switzerland, posted a five-game point streak (3-2=5) from Oct. 13 – 23, 2025, his 13th such streak of five games or longer, and is now within three points of becoming the second skater of Swiss nationality to reach the 500-point mark, following **Roman Josi** (191-538=729). Fiala enters tomorrow's matchup against a trio of his countrymen—**Nico Hischier**, **Timo Meier**, and **Jonas Siegenthaler**—and the New Jersey Devils having recorded four points (2-2=4) in the Devils' last three visits to Crypto.com Arena, dating back to Jan. 14, 2023. Fiala owns 11 career points (4-7=11), including a pair of power play goals, in 15 total games against the club from the Garden State.

SCARY PERRY

Forward **Corey Perry** played his first home game as an LA King at Crypto.com Arena on Thursday night against Detroit. Perry netted a pair of goals for his second multi-point outing in as many games (1-1=2 on Oct. 28 at SJS), which also extended his point streak to a fifth game (5-2=7). By doing so, Perry became the 23rd different skater 40 years of age or older to establish a point streak of at least five games, and the first since **Joe Thornton**'s seven-game stretch (2-5=7) from April 22 – May 6, 2021, with Toronto.

WE LOVE OUR SHORT(HANDED) KINGS

On Thursday against Detroit, forward **Alex Laferriere** scored the first shorthanded tally of his career, his third goal of the season overall. Laferriere became the 27th American-born skater to score a shorthanded goal in franchise history and the 20th to do so on home ice. With man-down contributions from **Trevor Moore** (Oct. 8 at VGK) and **Joel Armia** (Oct. 26 at CHI), the Kings' trio of shorthanded goals are the most by any team in the League through this point of the season. The team has scored three or more shorthanded goals through the first dozen games of a campaign only nine times in franchise history, most recently during the 2014-15 season.
