TEAM NOTES

TONIGHT'S MATCHUP

● The Maple Leafs are skating in their sixth game of the series tonight as they take on the Panthers at Amerant Bank Arena. The Maple Leafs have posted a 29-25 record in Game 6's in franchise best-of-seven series (12-8 on the road). The Maple Leafs have played 10 postseason games against the Panthers in franchise history (3-7), with a 1-3 record in four road games played. The Panthers have outscored the Maple Leafs 34-24 through 10 meetings. Through 11 games of the 2025 Stanley Cup Playoffs, William Nylander leads the team in goals with six and points with 15 (6G, 9A) while Mitch Marner leads the team in assists with 10.

LAST GAME

● The Maple Leafs lost 6-1 against the Florida Panthers on Wednesday night at Scotiabank Arena. Nicholas Robertson scored for the Maple Leafs at 18:54 of the third period, posting his first goal of the postseason. Max Domi recorded the primary assist on Robertson's goal. With his third assist of the postseason, Domi tied a single-season playoff career second-best in assists. Steven Lorentz registered the secondary assist on Robertson's goal, posting his second assist of the postseason. Joseph Woll stopped 20 of 25 shots he faced in Wednesday's loss. In relief, Matt Murray stopped 6 of 7 shots he faced. Murray appeared in the first playoff game of his career as a Maple Leaf. For the third-consecutive game, the Maple Leafs set a new 2025 Stanley Cup Playoffs single-game high in hits recording 49 hits. Bobby McMann set a new single-game playoff career-high with eight while Max Pacioretty tied a single-game playoff career-high with eight. Pacioretty is currently ranked third among all league skaters in hits during the 2025 Stanley Cup Playoffs with 55 registered through nine games.
