PLAYER NOTES

- Ryan Reaves scored for the Maple Leafs at 13:18 of the first period, scoring his fourth goal of the season.
- **TJ Brodie** scored for Toronto at 14:02 of the third period, scoring his first goal of the season. Brodie has recorded two points (1G, 1A) in his last three games played.
- **Pontus Holmberg** scored for the Maple Leafs at 16:20 of the third period, posting his seventh goal of the season.
- John Tavares scored for Toronto at 19:23 of the third period, posting his 29th goal of the season. Tavares has scored in four-consecutive games (5G).
- David Kämpf posted the primary assist on Reaves' goal and the secondary assist on Brodie's goal. Kämpf marked his first multi-assist (and multi-point) game of the season. Kämpf tied a single-game career-high in assists with two which he has marked on four occasions during his NHL career. He also tied a single-game career-high in points with two which he has marked on nine occasions during his NHL career. With two assists tonight, Kämpf recorded 11 assists this season, surpassing the 10-assist mark for the fifth campaign of his NHL career.
- Connor Dewar registered the secondary assist on Reaves' goal and the primary assist on Brodie's goal. Dewar recorded his first multi-assist game of the season and his second multi-point game of the season. Dewar tied a single-game career-high in assists with two which he has marked on three occasions during his NHL career. With his second assist of the game, Dewar recorded his 19th point of the season (11G, 8A), setting a new single-season career-high in points.
- **William Nylander** recorded the primary assist on Tavares' goal. Nylander added to his single-season careerhigh assist total with his 58th assist of the season.
- **Conor Timmins** recorded the secondary assist on Tavares' goal, posting his ninth assist of the season. With the assist, Timmins reached the 10-point mark (1G, 9A) for the second season of his NHL career (doing so in back-to-back seasons).
- Martin Jones stopped 26 of 32 shots he faced in tonight's loss.
- Simon Benoit was on the ice for a team-high 19 Toronto shot attempts-for at 5-on-5.
- **Connor Dewar** and **David Kämpf** finished the game with a team-high 5-on-5 shot attempt percentage of 61.54 percent (8 for, 5 against).

TEAM NOTES

- The Maple Leafs were 0-for-3 on the power play and 3-for-4 on the penalty kill tonight.
- Toronto has posted a 24-11-6 record on the road this season.
- The Maple Leafs have posted a 7-6-0 record in the second game of a back-to-back this season.
