TEAM NOTES

- ★ Columbus (2-0-1) and Toronto (1-1-1) concluded the three-game 2025-26 season series tonight. It's the third-straight campaign and seventh time in franchise history the Jackets have won the season series over the Maple Leafs (multiple goals).
- ★ CBJ have picked up points in seven of the past nine games against Toronto overall (6-2-1) and in four-straight home contests (3-0-1).
- ★ The Jackets shut down all Maple Leaf power plays during the season series (6-of-6) and have now stopped 13-of-13 man advantages in the last six matchups of the series.
- ★ The Jackets picked up a point for the eighth time in the last 10 games of the season (4-2-4) following tonight's overtime loss.
- ★ The club played in its ninth one-goal game (4-1-4) in the past 11 outings and the 13th time in the last 17 overall this season (7-2-4).
- ★ Columbus has picked up points in six-straight games at Nationwide Arena (4-0-2) since Oct. 29.

PLAYER NOTES

★ G Jet Greaves has helped the club earn points in each of his last eight starts dating back to Nov. 10 (4-0-4). It's tied for the eighth-longest stretch in franchise history (Elvis Merzlikins, Jan. 11-Feb. 7, 2020).

- ★ C Luca Pinelli (0-0-0, 1 GP) made his NHL debut tonight, posting two shots on goal on 16:20 of ice time. The 2023 fourth-round pick (114th overall) by Columbus has collected 5-5-10 in 13 games with the Cleveland Monsters (AHL) this season.
- ★ D Brendan Smith made his CBJ debut tonight, logging two shots on goal on 10:55 TOI.
- ★ D Zach Werenski (8-14-22, 24 GP) notched Columbus' lone goal and has 4-7-11 with point in seven of the last eight games. He improved to 2-19-21 in 20 career games against Toronto after registering points in all three games of the season series (2-4-6). He also has points in 10 of his last 12 against the Leafs (2-14-16).
- ★ LW Miles Wood (6-1-7, 18 GP) picked up his first assist as a Blue Jacket on Werenski's goal.
