THINGS YOU SHOULD KNOW

Buffalo has earned at least one point in six consecutive games against Minnesota (5-0-1), the team's longest point streak against the Wild in franchise history.

Four of the last six contests between the Sabres and the Wild have been decided in overtime or a shootout.

Alex Tuch is riding a six-game point streak and he has recorded nine points (3+6) in that span.

Rasmus Dahlin has notched 17 points (6+11) in his last 13 games, including at least one point in seven straight home games (3+8).

Tage Thompson has recorded at least one point in four consecutive games and he has five points (4+1) in that span.



Thompson has scored one goal in four straight games and a goal in tonight's game would give him the longest goal streak of his career.

JJ Peterka has registered at least one point in four consecutive home contests (3+3).

point in tonight's game would give Peterka the longest home point streak of his career.

In his last three home games, Owen Power has tallied four assists, including at least one assist in each of those games.

SPECIAL FORCES

The Sabres rank sixth among all NHL teams in power-play percentage (26.5) and penalty-kill percentage (85.7) since Nov. 1.

Buffalo is tied for third in both power-play goals (9) and power-play net goals (9) in November, despite ranking 13th among all NHL teams in power-play time on ice per game (4:50) in that span.

The Sabres' penalty kill has allowed just one goal in their last 18 power-play attempts (94.4 percent) against and they have killed 15 consecutive penalties.

Buffalo is tied for eighth among all NHL teams in net penalty-kill percentage (84.9) this season.

Rasmus Dahlin has posted 10 points (3+7) in nine career games against the Wild.

In his last three games against Minnesota, Dylan **Cozens** has tallied three points (2+1).

In four career games against the Wild, Ukko-Pekka Luukkonen has posted a save percentage of .923 and a goals-against average of 2.60.

Tage Thompson has recorded five points

(1+4) in his last five games against Minnesota, including at least one point in back-to-back games and one point in three consecutive home contests against the Wild.

Henri Jokiharju has registered at least one point in back-to-back games (2+1) against Minnesota and he has notched four points in his last four games against the Wild (2+2).
