THINGS YOU SHOULD KNOW

The Sabres have earned at least one point in four of their last five games against the Penguins (3-1-1), including at least one point in back-to-back road contests in Pittsburgh (1-0-1).

Tage Thompson is riding a six-game goal streak, the longest such streak of his career.

Thompson has registered nine points (6+3) in that span of games.

A goal today would make **Thompson** the first Sabres skater to register a goal streak of seven or more games since Miroslav Satan (8 games; Dec. 19, 1998 to Jan. 2, 1999).

Thompson has the second-longest active goal streak in the NHL (Jason Robertson, 7 games).

Rasmus Dahlin has tallied seven assists in his last five games.

In his last five games, **Mattias Samuelsson** has posted five points (3+2).



Alex Tuch has recorded nine points (3+6) in his last eight games, including at least one point in back-to-back games.

In his last three games, **Jason Zucker** has posted five points (1+4), including at least one point in each of those games.

Ryan McLeod has recorded two points in each of his last two games (1+3).

With a multi-point performance tonight, **McLeod** would become the first Sabres forward since JJ Peterka from March 3 to 6, 2025 (2+4) to tally multiple points in three straight games.

Josh Doan has collected six points (3+3) in his last six games and he has recorded at least one point in back-to-back games.

Zach Benson has recorded one assist in each of his last two games played.

Jack Quinn has registered three points (2+1) in his last two games, including one goal in back-to-back games.

Beck Malenstyn has two points (1+1) in his last two games and he needs one point to register a career-long three-game point streak.

ON THIS DATE

The Sabres are 12-7-1 all-time on November 26.

November 26, 1972: Rene Robert, Rick Martin and Jim Lorentz each score two goals as the Sabres defeat the Islanders, 9-2.

November 26, 1982: The Sabres get goals from six different skaters and outlast the Blues, winning 8-6 in a game that saw both starting goaltenders replaced in the second period.

HAPPY FEET

Alex Tuch is riding a five-game point streak against the Penguins (Nov. 24, 2023 to March 27, 2025; 5 games; 3+5).

A point in tonight's game would make **Tuch** the first Sabres skater to record a point streak of six or more games against Pittsburgh since Thomas Vanek from Oct. 15, 2011 to Oct. 5, 2013 (7 games; 6+4).

Tage Thompson is riding a four-game point streak (2+2) against Pittsburgh and if he records a point in tonight's game it would mark the first time a Sabres skater has done so in five or more consecutive games against the Penguins since **Tuch**.

Bowen Byram has recorded at least one assist in each of the three games he has played against Pittsburgh as a member of the Sabres and he has five assists in that span.

Jason Zucker has recorded five points (1+4) in his last five games against Pittsburgh.
