Post-Game Notes

- The Tampa Bay Lightning defeated the Carolina Hurricanes 4-0 on Friday night at AMALIE Arena.
- The Lightning improved to 2-1-0 in the 2023-24 preseason and to 96-70-13 with 15 ties all-time.
- The Hurricanes outshot the Lightning 42-28, including a 16-7 advantage in the third period.
- Felix Robert and Mikey Eyssimont led the Lightning with four shots on goal apiece.
- Lightning goaltender Jonas Johansson stopped all 42 shots he faced to earn a shutout in his first preseason game as a Bolt.
- Johansson started two games for the Colorado Avalanche last season and recorded two wins and a .932 save percentage. He also played 26 games for the AHL Colorado Eagles where he posted a 14-9-2 record with a .920 save percentage.
- The Lightning won 27 of 60 faceoffs but were led by Anthony Cirelli (9 for 18) and Luke Glendening (8 for 16) who each won 50% of their draws.
- Haydn Fleury paced the Lightning with three hits.
- Sean Day and Tyler Motte each blocked a team-high three shots.
- Through three preseason games, Tampa Bay's power play is running at 40% (4 for 10). Entering Friday night, the Bolts power play was running at a league-best 42.9% (3 for 7).
- Anthony Cirelli got the Bolts on the board with a backhand shot from the slot, giving Tampa Bay a 1-0 lead at 16:57 of the first period. Cirelli's first goal of the

preseason came unassisted.

- Cirelli skated in 58 games last season after undergoing shoulder surgery in the offseason and posted 29 points (11-18—29 pts.).
- Felix Robert scored his first preseason goal on the power play to extend Tampa Bay's lead to 2-0 at 13:06 of the second period.
- Robert appeared in 55 games with the Syracuse Crunch in 2022-23, recording 18 goals and 34 points.
- Robert has tallied one goal and one assist in his two preseason games this season.
- Mikey Eyssimont tallied the primary assist after completing a give-and-go pass with Conor Sheary. The assist was Eyssimont's second of the preseason (0-2—2 pts.).
- Sheary recorded the secondary assist on the play, marking his third point in his two preseason appearances (1-2—3 pts.).
- Anthony Cirelli scored his second goal of the night, firing a one timer from the right circle to give Tampa Bay a 3-0 lead.
- Cirelli's goal came shorthanded at 14:05 of the third period.
- Zach Bogosian collected his first point of the preseason, setting up Cirelli for the shorthanded goal.
- Luke Glendening added to the Bolts lead at 15:45 of the third period, making the score 4-0 Tampa Bay.
- Glendening skated in 70 games with the Dallas Stars in 2022-23 and registered six points (3-3—6 pts.).
- Felix Robert notched his second point of the night with the primary assist on Glendening's goal.
- Tyler Motte also collected an assist on the play, his second point of the preseason (1-1—2 pts.).
- The Lightning return to action tomorrow night when they take on the Nashville Predators at AMALIE Arena (5:00pm puck drop).
