- The Stars will hold practice at 11 a.m. at Comerica Center on Thursday, Jan. 11.

NOTES

- The Stars swept their three-game season series against the Wild and extended their head-to-head point streak to 10 games dating to Dec. 20, 2021 (7-0-3) – their longest active run against one opponent. It's their lengthiest point streak against any club since posting a 10-0-3 record against the Capitals from Oct. 25, 2008 to Dec. 19, 2017.
- Dallas became the first team this season to have at least four players with 15 goals. The only teams with three are the Avalanche, Oilers, Penguins, Lightning, Maple Leafs, Canucks and Golden Knights. It marks the first time in Dallas Stars history (1993-present) that they've had as many through 40 games played; the only other instances in franchise history are 1982-83 (5), 1989-90 (4), 1985-86 (4), 1983-84 (4), 1981-82 (4) and 1979-80 (4).
- The Stars outscored the Wild 19-5 in the three head-to-head matchups this season.
- Forward **Joe Pavelski** (1,290 GP) tonight passed **Mathieu Schneider** (1,289 GP) for eighth place on the NHL's all-time games played list among U.S.-born players. Pavelski tallied his 16th goal of the season in the first period, good for second the team lead in that category behind **Rooper Hintz** (17).
- It was Pavelski's 465th career goal to move him within three of tying **Pat LaFontaine** (468) for fifth-most in NHL history among U.S.-born players. Pavelski has scored against 150 different goaltenders in the regular season and trails only 12 players in league history and only one active player (**Alex Ovechkin**, who ranks third with 172).
- Defenseman **Esa Lindell** tied his career high in assists (3) and points (0-3—3) in a game, a feat he's accomplished five times and the first since Nov. 13, 2022 at Philadelphia (1-2—3).
- Forward **Jason Robertson** (1-0—1) lit the lamp for the third consecutive game (3-1—4) to give him a team-best 41 points (15-26—41).
- Forward **Matt Duchene** (1-0—1) tallied his 12th goal of the season to give him points in five of his past six games (1-6—7).
- Forward **Rooper Hintz** (1-0—1) recorded his team-leading 17th goal of the season to give him goals in consecutive games against the Wild (2-1—3). Hintz has 36 points (17-19—36) in 38 GP this season.
- Forward **Mason Marchment** registered his ninth multi-point game of the season with two assists (0-2—2) to give him 32 points (13-19—32) in 40 GP. Marchment has 11 points (3-8—11) in his past six games.
- Defenseman **Nils Lundkvist** scored his first goal of the season as part of a multi-point effort (1-1—2).
- Goaltender **Scott Wedgewood** made 21 saves on 23 shots to improve his record this season to 12-4-3.
