## **TEAM NOTES**

- Philadelphia owns an 8-8-2 record against the Eastern Conference this season, including a 3-4-0 record against Metropolitan opponents.
- Per NHL Stats, the Flyers scored multiple game-tying goals in the final 10 minutes of regulation for the fourth time in franchise history (3/26/24, 10/18/14, 3/30/91).
- Per NHL Stats, the Flyers won their seventh game via overtime or a shootout this season, tying the Oilers for the most wins in extra time this season.
- Morgan Frost recorded his fourth multi-point game of the season, scoring twice in tonight's matchup. He owns seven points (4g-3a) in his last seven games against Columbus.
- Owen Tippett recorded a career-high four-point game tonight, registering a goal and three assists. This performance marked his fifth multi-point game of the season and has 11 points (7g-4a) in his last 10 games, 11/30-12/21.
- **Tippett's** overtime goal was his third overtime goal in his career and his 10th career game-winning goal. He ranks tied for third among active Flyers in career overtime goals.
