Today's matchup is Islanders General Manager Lou Lamoriello's 324th career postseason game, tying Glen Sather for the most by any General Manager in NHL history. Lamoriello also enters today's game with 171 career playoff wins, the second-most by any GM in league history.

Islanders Captain Anders Lee has recorded a point in all three games of Round One. It is the first time since August 24-29, 2020 that Lee has found the scoresheet in three straight postseason games.

BROCK NELSON #29

Islanders forward Brock Nelson scored his first goal of the 2024 Stanley Cup Playoffs on Thursday night in Game Three. It was the 26th goal and 48th point of Nelson's postseason career, leading active Islanders skaters. The Warroad, MN native has recorded a goal and an assist in his last two games, and his eight points (four goals, four assists) in 13 playoff games against Carolina leads the franchise. This season, Nelson also led the Islanders with 34 goals in 82 games, the fifth straight year he led the Islanders in the category.



Andrei Svechnikov #37

Carolina forward Andrei Svechnikov has recorded two assists in each of his last two games, joining Cale Makar as the only skaters with more than one multi-assist game this postseason. A native of Barnaul, RUS, Svechnikov had 52 points (19 goals, 33 assists) in 59 games this season, his third straight 50-point campaign. The 24-year-old also recorded four assists in four meetings with the Islanders during the regular season. He has 29 points (13 goals, 16 assists) in 43 career playoff games, all with Carolina.
