- The Stars earned their 19th comeback win in 2023-24. Entering play Saturday, the only teams with as many were the Devils (20) and Oilers (19).
- Forward **Jason Robertson** (1-0—1) scored the game-tying goal on the power play at the 4:08 mark of the third period to extend his point streak to three games (2-1—3). Through 63 GP, Robertson leads the Stars in assists (39) and points (21-39—60) and shares third in goals (21).
- Captain **Jamie Benn** (0-1—1) earned an assist on Robertson's game-tying goal and scored the game-deciding goal in the shootout. Benn has points in two straight games (0-2—2) and 36 points (9-27—36) overall.
- Defenseman **Miro Heiskanen** (0-1—1) recorded his 31st assist of the season. Heiskanen paces Stars blueliners in assists and points (7-31—38) in 53 GP.
- Forward **Radek Faksa** (1-0—1) scored his fourth goal of the season at the 3:08 mark of the second period.
